Day 1: Travel day

Board your overnight flight to Florence today.

Florence → 4 nights

Day 2: Arrival in Florence

Included meals: welcome dinner

Welcome to Italy! Meet your Tour Director and fellow travelers at tonight's welcome dinner.

Day 3: Sightseeing tour of Florence

Included meals: breakfast

Get to know Florence, the birthplace of the Renaissance, as you make your way through the UNESCO-recognized historic center with a local guide.

- View the legendary Florence Cathedral, known as the Duomo.
- Pass Giotto's Campanile, a masterpiece of Gothic architecture.
- Step inside the Basilica of Santa Croce, burial site of Michelangelo, Machiavelli, and Galileo.
- See the medieval Ponte Vecchio and Piazza della Signoria, the center of Florentine life.

Day 6: Italian Riviera via Lucca

Included meals: breakfast

Known for its Renaissance-era walls, Lucca sits in the heart of Tuscany. You'll get to know the town on a guided tour.

- Walk along a section of the city's walls and learn about their illustrious history.
- Take in impressive views of the classic red-tiled rooftops, medieval churches, and swath of cypress trees below.
- Descend into the center of town to view the Palazzo Pfanner, Guinigi Tower, and Basilica of San Frediano.
- Enter San Martino Cathedral and San Michele in Foro, a basilica known for its intricately inlaid facade.

This afternoon, continue to the Italian Riviera.

Day 7: Sightseeing tour of Cinque Terre

Included meals: breakfast

Join your Tour Director to discover Cinque Terre, an idyllic cluster of five villages set on seaside cliffs.

- Board a train to Monterosso and soak in views of the pebble beach that the village is known for.
- Hop aboard a boat to the village of Vernazza and admire the colorful houses that dot the waterfront.
- Continue by boat to the dramatic coastal village of Riomaggiore.
- Learn about Via dell'Amore, one of the area's most famous hiking paths, which connects two of the five villages.
- Enjoy short walks through each village before spending free time exploring, shopping, and eating.
- Admire the Liguria regions' varied landscape as you transfer back to your hotel by train.

Please note: The boat ride is weather-dependent.

In the case of inclement weather, you'll visit the villages by train. In addition, the specific villages you visit may vary.

Day 8: Free day on the Italian Riviera

Day 9: Transfer to Lake Como & sightseeing tour

Head north to beautiful Lake Como, located in the foothills of the Alps, where your Tour Director introduces you to the waterfront city of Como.

- See Como's eclectic architecture, glittering lakefront, and mountain scenery.
- View Como Cathedral, one of the last Gothic cathedrals built in Italy.

Day 3: Fiesole Villa Dinner

\$99/\$109* (4 hours, departs in the evening, dinner included)

Head just outside Florence to Fiesole, a historic Tuscan town perched on a hill overlooking the Renaissance city. Tonight's dinner is set in a picturesque villa with panoramic views of the city below. Start your evening with an aperitif and then enjoy a refined Italian dinner with local wine. Please note: This excursion is seasonal and runs from April to October. Additionally, the aperitif may be enjoyed inside in the case of inclement weather.

lunch of local seafood and meat specialties paired with regional wine. Then, stroll through the village castle gardens and take in views of both Baia delle Silenzio and another bay known as Baia delle Favole. Next, hop aboard a ferry to make your way to the breathtaking village of Portofino. Artists and celebrities alike flock to this celebrated destination, and you'll enjoy free time for shopping or relaxing while admiring the picturesque vistas of the harbor. Please note: This excursion is seasonal and runs from March through November. It also involves a moderate amount of walking.

Day 4: The Leaning Tower of Pisa

\$105/\$115* (6.5 hours, departure time varies)

Travel through the Tuscan countryside for a visit to Pisa's Piazza dei Miracoli, or Field of Miracles, to see the famed Leaning Tower. Admire the Pisan Romanesque marble facade of the adjacent UNESCO-listed 11th-century cathedral before stepping inside. Then, gaze at Giovanni Pisano's Gothic pulpit inside the Baptistery of St. John. End your time with a gelato tasting. Please note, entrance into the tower is not included.

Extension excursion options

Day 10: Lake Como Cruise & Bellagio

\$105/\$115* (5 hours, departs in the evening with dinner)

Hop aboard a scenic cruise of Lake Como to soak in some of Italy's most beautiful estates and gardens. Float past charming lakeside towns to Bellagio, a village whose scenery has inspired poets and young lovers for centuries. You'll have time to take in Bellagio's classic beauty before heading to a local restaurant, where you'll sample cuisine from a carefully chosen menu. Please note: Your included meal may be lunch or dinner as departure time varies by season. This excursion is weather-dependent.

Day 4: Tuscan Cooking Class & Dinner

\$115 (2.5 hours, departs in the evening with dinner)

This evening, learn how to make a traditional Tuscan meal under the direction of expert local chefs. Craft authentic pici, a thick, hand-rolled pasta, two kinds of bruschetta, and tiramisu. Then, pair your creations with wine, and sit down to a delicious dinner with your group. Please note: Depending on the size of the group, the class may be divided into two shifts. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 20 days prior to departure.

Day 5: Siena & San Gimignano: Tuscan Hilltowns

\$125/\$135* (10 hours, departs in the morning)

Discover the essence of Tuscany on a full-day excursion. In Siena, a local guide introduces you to the town and its black-and-white marble duomo, where you'll find brilliantly colored 16th-century frescoes in the Piccolomini Library. You'll have some free time to explore the Campo, the square that serves as the center of civic life in Siena. Then, journey through the countryside to the town of San Gimignano, where you'll have some free time to explore the city's medieval towers or simply admire the Tuscan hills. Later, you'll head to a nearby vineyard, where an included wine tasting awaits. Please note: This excursion involves a moderate amount of walking.

Day 8: Villages of the Italian Riviera & Lunch

\$115/\$125* (7.5 hours, departs in the morning, lunch included)

Drive through the countryside to Sestri Levante, a beautiful seaside village located on the Italian Riviera. Here, you'll have free time to explore on your own before setting out on a walk along the coastline to Baia delle Silenzio, one of the city's sparkling azure bays. Enjoy stunning bayside views while eating a delicious
