Over 70 brightly-hued acres burst with seven million flowers in bloom, from daffodils to hyacinths to the country's most famous export: The tulip. Spend some time getting to know the charming city of Amsterdam before escaping to the peaceful, perfumed gardens.

- Arrive in Keukenhof, home of the secondlargest flower garden on Earth

 Explore the grounds of Keukenhof, where more than 7 million flowers burst into bloom each spring, including yellow daffodils, crocus, narcissi, hyacinths, as well as over 1,000 colorful and original varieties of tulips

Day 3: Food of Amsterdam Walking Tour

\$99/\$109* (2.5 hours, departure time varies) Get a taste of sweet and savory Dutch dishes on a culinary walking tour through Amsterdam. Meet your local guide at Beursplein Square, which is located in front of the Amsterdam Stock Exchange, and walk through the old city center, an area once known as the Red Light District. Make your way to your first stop, a chocolate and spice shop set along Amsterdam's oldest canal. There, you'll taste award-winning chocolate and an iconic Dutch sweet, the stroopwafel, as you learn about Amsterdam's role in the 17th-century spice trade. Continue on to a cheese shop to sample several varieties made by a local family. Next, follow the bustling Zeedijk (or sea dike, in Dutch) through the heart of Chinatown and visit a family of fishmongers who have been in business since 1938. There, taste raw herring and kibbeling, or battered, fried fish. Wrap up your tour with a visit to an award-winning microbrewery, where you'll enjoy beer and a selection of Dutch snacks. Spend some free time in the city before heading back to your hotel. Please note: This excursion is only offered from mid-May through December.

Day 4: A Day in Charming Delft

\$129/\$139* (8 hours, departs in the morning)
Pay a visit to the world-famous flower market at
Aalsmeer for a close-up look at one of Holland's bestknown national exports: its brilliantly hued tulips.
Continue to Delft, a charming town of canals, cobbled
alleyways and medieval architecture. Visit the Old and
New Churches on a guided tour, and then enjoy free
time to grab lunch and explore the town, perhaps
visiting the former home of the famous painter,
Vermeer. Please note: A visit to the Hague will replace
the flower market on days when the market is closed.

Extension excursion options

Day 6: Van Gogh & the Dutch Countryside

\$135/\$145* (9 hours, departs in the morning)
This morning, leave the busy streets of Amsterdam for the tranquil Dutch countryside. Your destination is the heaths and sand dunes of Hoge Veluwe National Park, one of the largest nature preserves in this small country. Once you arrive at the park, you'll have the day to explore as you like. Rent one of the free bicycles the park provides to visitors, or step inside the Kröller-Müeller Museum and sculpture garden, home to the world's largest collection of van Gogh art. The museum also houses masterpieces from Mondrian, Seurat, Gauguin, and Picasso.
