



Highlights of England, Scotland & Ireland

12 days | 14 days with London extension

Embark on a guided tour of England, Scotland, and Ireland, which will take you from cosmopolitan London to the medieval city of Edinburgh. Then, pass through the Lake District and Wales as you travel between Scotland and Ireland. After arriving in the Emerald Isle, grab a pint (or a few) with Dubliners and make your way along the scenic Ring of Kerry and Cliffs of Moher, taking in stunning sea views as you go.

Overnight Flight → 1 night

Day 1: Travel day

Board your overnight flight to London today.

London → 2 nights

Day 2: Arrival in London

Included meals: welcome dinner

Welcome to England! Meet your Tour Director and fellow travelers at tonight's welcome dinner.

Day 3: Sightseeing tour of London

Included meals: breakfast

View the regal landmarks of England's vibrant and cosmopolitan capital on a guided sightseeing tour.

- Pass the grand Trafalgar Square and Baroque-style St. Paul's Cathedral, perched atop Ludgate Hill
- See Westminster Abbey, the setting for royal coronations, weddings, and funerals
- View icons like Big Ben, the London Eye, Tower Bridge, and the Tower of London
- Stop by Buckingham Palace, where you may catch the Changing of the Guard

+ Windsor Castle

Edinburgh → 2 nights

Day 4: Train ride to Edinburgh

Included meals: breakfast, dinner

Journey by train through the English countryside and past the lochs and hills of Scotland. Later, arrive in the Edinburgh and sit down for an included dinner.

Please note: Travelers may need to handle their own luggage on the train.

Day 5: Sightseeing tour of Edinburgh

Included meals: breakfast

Get to know Edinburgh in all its medieval beauty on a tour led by a local expert.

- View the elegant Georgian-style New Town and the Royal Mile, two UNESCO World Heritage sites

- Pass the Sir Walter Scott monument, the largest monument to a writer in the world
- Enter Edinburgh Castle to view the Scottish crown jewels and Stone of Scone

Spend a free afternoon in Edinburgh or add an excursion.

+ Abbotsford House & Melrose Abbey

Liverpool → 1 night

Day 6: Transfer to Liverpool

Included meals: breakfast

Travel through the emerald green landscapes of Northern England, stopping in the town of Kendal for free time to enjoy a cup of tea and sample some of Kendal's famous Mint Cake. Then, continue on to Liverpool, England and enjoy a free evening in the city or add an excursion.

+ The Beatles: History & Story Museum

Dublin → 2 nights

Day 7: Ferry to Dublin

Included meals: breakfast

Travel through northern Wales and stop in the village of Llanfairpwllgwyngyllgogerychwyrndrobwlantysiliogogogoch, which is the longest-named place in Europe. Then, continue on to Holyhead and board a ferry across the Irish Sea to Dublin.

Day 8: Sightseeing tour of Dublin

Included meals: breakfast

Take a comprehensive tour of Ireland's capital city with a local expert leading the way.

- Stop in Phoenix Park, site of the presidential residence, and pass by the Guinness Brewery
- Step inside the soaring St. Patrick's Cathedral, Ireland's largest church
- Pass St Stephen's Green and admire the Georgian architecture of Merrion Square as you go
- See Trinity College and walk past Grafton Street to the Molly Malone statue, ending in the Temple Bar district

+ Traditional Irish Dinner & Show

County Kerry → 2 nights

Day 9: County Kerry via Blarney

Included meals: breakfast, dinner

Continue your journey through the Emerald Isle today.

- Make a photo stop at the famed Rock of Cashel
- Enter Blarney Castle to kiss the legendary Blarney Stone

Continue on to County Kerry and sit down for an included dinner this evening.

Day 10: Sightseeing tour of the Ring of Kerry

Included meals: breakfast

Set out on the Ring of Kerry, a 112-mile coastal route that covers some of Ireland's most spectacular scenery.

- Pass the pristine Lakes of Killarney in Killarney National Park and gaze across Dingle Bay
- Enjoy unsurpassable views of mountains, beaches, and the Atlantic Ocean
- Explore the picturesque villages that line the Ring of Kerry including the village of Sneem, "The Knot in the Ring"

Dublin → 1 night

Day 11: Dublin via the Cliffs of Moher

Included meals: breakfast, farewell dinner

This morning, travel north to walk along the mesmerizing coastline of the Cliffs of Moher. Continue on to Dublin this afternoon and celebrate your trip during a farewell dinner.

Flight Home

Day 12: Departure

Included meals: breakfast (excluding early morning departures)

Transfer to the airport for your flight home.

+ London extension

Day 3: Windsor Castle

\$125 (5 hours, departs in the afternoon)

Led by a Blue Badge Guide, you'll travel to Windsor for a guided tour of the world's largest and longest-inhabited castle. Founded by William the Conqueror in 1070, Windsor has been the British Royal Family's preferred retreat for the past 900 years. Step inside the State Apartments and St. George's Chapel, where knighting ceremonies of the Most Noble Order of the Garter take place. View the exhibit of royal treasures within the castle. You'll then have time to stroll through the town of Windsor and have a look at Eton College, a prestigious prep school attended by Princes William and Harry. Please note: When the Windsor Castle excursion falls on a Wednesday, entrance will be replaced by an excursion to Hampton Court. For any departures where the Windsor Castle excursion falls on a Tuesday, the excursion will be moved to another day on tour or cancelled. Additionally, St. George's Chapel is closed to the public on Sundays. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 20 days prior to departure.

Extension excursion options

Day 3: Stonehenge & Salisbury

\$149 (7 hours, departs in the morning)

After a scenic drive through gently rolling countryside, arrive at Stonehenge, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of England's most recognizable icons. Get an informative overview of the its history at the visitor's center before exploring the monument. Then, head to the nearby town of Salisbury to peruse its famed Charter Market and visit Salisbury Cathedral, home to one of the four surviving original copies of the Magna Carta. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 20 days prior to departure.

Day 5: Abbotsford House & Melrose Abbey

\$109/\$119* (5 hours, departs in the afternoon with lunch)

Travel through the Scottish Borders region to Abbotsford, where you'll enjoy an included lunch. Continue on to Abbotsford House, the 19th-century estate of Sir Walter Scott. The poet designed his home in the Romantic style to imitate the elaborate baronial estates of British aristocrats. Today, it serves as a museum for Scottish memorabilia and artifacts that Walter Scott collected throughout his lifetime. Later, visit the ruins of Melrose Abbey, one of the most impressive of the four Borders abbeys. Please note: Some areas of the abbey are closed off due to masonry and damage repairs.

Day 6: The Beatles: History & Story Museum

\$105/\$115* (4 hours, departs in the afternoon)

Curious about how the Fab Four came to be? This excursion is your opportunity to discover the humble beginnings of the band that achieved global stardom. View special exhibitions, memorabilia, and photographs at the immersive Beatles Story Museum. Then, join a local expert for a guided tour of Liverpool, with special visits to Beatles-specific landmarks such as Penny Lane and Strawberry Fields.

Day 8: Traditional Irish Dinner & Show

\$109/\$119* (5 hours, departs in the evening with dinner)

Enjoy this special evening of Irish food, music, and live entertainment. Dinner will be served first, giving you a taste of the country's traditional dishes. You'll then be treated to a live show of Irish music and dance. Join in the fun as you enjoy a merry and memorable night. Please note: The specific venue and day of the week for this excursion may change due to availability. This
