# Day 4: Flight to Edinburgh & evening ghost tour

# **London** $\rightarrow$ 3 nights

# Day 6: Train ride to London & Jack the Ripper tour

Included meals: breakfast
Journey by train through Scotland and the
English countryside, and arrive in the English
capital. After some free time, join your group and
a local expert for a spooky tour of London's East
End to learn about the unsolved murders

committed by Jack the Ripper.

 Explore the dark, narrow streets of the Whitechapel and Spitalfields neighborhoods.

 Retrace the steps of the 19th-century serial killer and his victims to find out more about the crimes that captivated the world.

Please note: Porterage is not included for the train transfers. Travelers must be comfortable lifting and carrying all luggage over steps, onto platforms, and into luggage storage.

## Day 7: Sightseeing tour of London

sightseeing tour.

- Pass the grand Trafalgar Square and Baroquestyle St. Paul's Cathedral, perched atop Ludgate Hill.
- See Westminster Abbey, the setting for royal coronations, weddings, and funerals.
- View icons like Big Ben, the London Eye,
   Tower Bridge, and the Tower of London.

 Stop by Buckingham Palace, where you may catch the Changing of the Guard.

#### Day 3: Haunted Hell Fire Club

\$145CAD (4 hours, departs in the afternoon)
Surrounded by centuries of folklore, Montpelier Hill is considered one of the most haunted sites in Ireland. It's home to the Hell Fire Club, a roughly 300-year-old lodge that was supposedly used as a gathering place for debauchery and devil worship until it caught fire, killing several members. On this tour, you'll explore the grounds of the Hell Fire Club and the nearby Killakee Stewards House, another haunted site used by the club, before finishing your ghastly adventure over a pint at a local pub. Please note: This excursion involves a fair amount of walking, including uphill portions.

Participants should wear comfortable shoes and warm clothing. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 20 days prior to departure.

#### **Day 7: Hampton Court Palace Ghost Tour**

\$175CAD (3 hours, departs in the afternoon)
Discover a darker side to the Hampton Court Palace, a royal palace in the outskirts of London, on this afternoon tour through the palace and grounds. Follow a local expert through beautiful rooms, eerie cloisters, and creepy courtyards as you learn the tales of the palace's paranormal activity and rumored resident ghosts, including two of King Henry VIII's wives. Please note: This excursion also involves a fair amount of walking, including uneven terrain. Participants should wear comfortable shoes and warm clothing. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 20 days prior to departure.

#### Day 8: The Tower of London's Dark Past

\$185CAD (3 hours, departs in the morning)
The Tower of London is one of the city's most famous landmarks, but this excursion shows off a different, more gruesome side to the iconic castle. On this tour, a local guide will shed light on the fortress's diverse history, focusing on its role as a prison. You'll explore some of the ground's grimmer areas and torture sites, including the Bloody Tower, the Tower Green, and the scaffold site. Please note: This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 20 days prior to departure.
