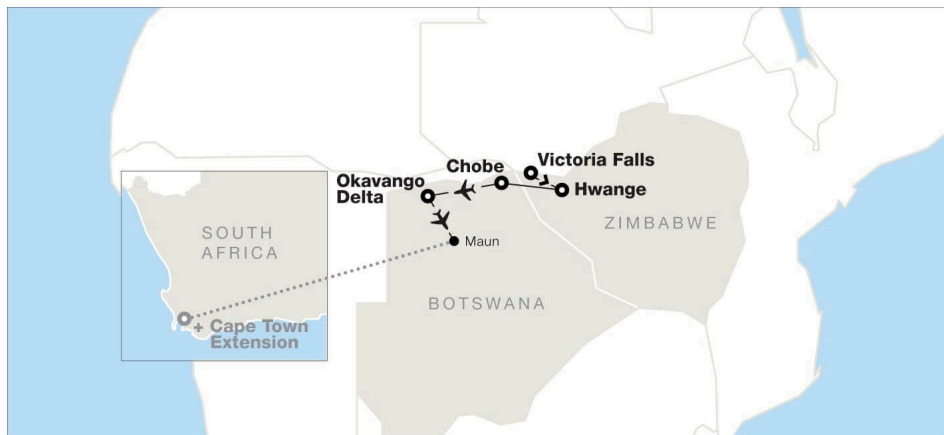




Botswana & Zimbabwe Wildlife Safari

12 days | 16 days with Cape Town extension

After an introduction to the continent at Victoria Falls, spend a week scanning the horizon for cheetah in Hwange National Park, tracking the elephant herds in Chobe, and gliding through the lush lagoons of the Okavango Delta. Journey from grasslands to woodlands, through waterways and byways, to experience Africa's incredible diversity on this small group Safari Tour.

Overnight Flight → 1 night

Day 1: Travel day

Board your overnight flight to Johannesburg today.

Victoria Falls → 3 nights

Day 2: Arrival in Johannesburg & transfer to Victoria Falls

Included meals: dinner

Land in Johannesburg, South Africa and board your connecting flight to Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe. Later, meet your fellow travelers at a welcome dinner.

Day 3: Victoria Falls National Park

Included meals: breakfast

Set out to experience the power and beauty of Victoria Falls firsthand.

- Discover the falls from multiple angles and learn about the area's flora and fauna
- Visit the Rose of Charity, an organization helping to transform the lives of impoverished children, their families, and their communities through education

Day 4: Free day in Victoria Falls & anti-poaching talk

Included meals: breakfast

Enjoy a free day in Victoria Falls.

This evening, meet and interact with the seasoned anti-poaching activist during an informative talk.

- Hear how locals, international organizations, and indigenous communities work together to protect the wildlife
- Hear about the anti-poaching efforts in southern Africa, with a special focus on elephants and rhinos
- Ask the expert questions during the chat

Please note: The anti-poaching talk may be moved to another evening depending on the speaker's availability.

Hwange → 2 nights

Day 5: Transfer to Hwange National Park &

game drive

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner

Travel to Hwange National Park, the largest game reserve in Zimbabwe. Enjoy an included lunch before setting out on a game drive.

- Ramble across sweeping landscapes during a short sunset drive through Hwange Conservancy in the late afternoon
- Keep watch for over 100 species of mammals and 400 species of birds that make their home in the park

Sit down for an included dinner this evening.

Day 6: Hwange National Park game drives

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner

Embark on a full-day of game drives in Hwange National Park.

- Experience the diverse landscape of dense teak forest and open grassy plains with acacia as well as islands of mopane woodland and ilala palms
- Spot herds of buffalo, prides of lions, and a wealth of plains game
- Enjoy an included picnic lunch
- See elephants trudge along in herds
- Scan the landscape in search of giraffes

Sit down for an included dinner this evening.

Chobe → 2 nights

Day 7: Hwange National Park game drive & transfer to Chobe National Park

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner

Get a chance to see more wildlife on an early morning game drive in Hwange National Park. Then, cross the border into Botswana and enter Chobe National Park, one of Africa's best off-the-beaten-path safari destinations.

- Enjoy an included lunch
- Take a peaceful late-afternoon wildlife cruise along the Chobe River
- Watch for elephants, crocodiles, and hippos who come to drink and bathe at sunset

Sit down for an included dinner this evening.

Day 8: Impalila Island & Chobe National Park game drive

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner

Spend another day roaming among Chobe's exotic wildlife.

- Cross the border into Namibia to walk around the village on Impalila Island and visit with the community there
- Enjoy an included lunch
- Embark on a late afternoon game drive in Chobe National Park, which boasts Africa's highest concentration of elephants

Sit down for an included dinner this evening.

Okavango Delta → 2 nights

Day 9: Chobe National Park game drive & flight to Okavango Delta

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner

Follow a local guide along the varied landscapes of Chobe on an early morning game drive before flying by chartered plane to Botswana's Okavango Delta.

- Enjoy an included lunch
- Explore the delta's serene surroundings by boat
- Glide along reed-fringed waterways to see wildlife from a different perspective

Please note: The boating excursions are dependent upon water levels. If the water levels aren't high enough, the tours will be conducted in safari Jeeps.

Sit down for an included dinner this evening.

Day 10: Okavango Delta

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner

Begin your day floating along the delta's tranquil channels in your *mokoro*, a traditional canoe.

- Keep your eyes peeled for giraffe, lion, leopard, jackal, impala, red lechwe, and other denizens of the delta
- Traverse the region's rugged landscape on a guided bush walk
- Enjoy an included lunch
- Take to the water again on a motorized boat

Please note: The boating excursions are dependent upon water levels. If the water levels aren't high enough, the tours will be conducted in safari Jeeps.

Celebrate your adventures with your fellow travelers at a farewell dinner.

Overnight Flight → 1 night

Day 11: Morning boating excursion & departure

Included meals: breakfast

Get one last glimpse of Africa's wild landscapes on a boating excursion. Then, take a chartered flight to Maun to connect to your overnight flight home or continue on to Cape Town, South Africa.

Day 12: Arrival at home

Arrive home today.

+ Cape Town extension

From the top of Table Mountain to Cape Point at the tip of the African continent, Cape Town is, in a word, impressive. Fly to South Africa to discover this magnificent metropolis and its stunning surroundings with local guides in the lead.

Cape Town → 4 nights

Day 11: Flight to Cape Town

Included meals: breakfast

Fly from Maun to Johannesburg and continue on to the jewel of southern Africa: Cape Town.

Day 12: Sightseeing tour of Cape Town

Included meals: breakfast

Join your Tour Director for a tour of Cape Town, a beautiful and culturally rich city.

- Take a cable car ride up Table Mountain and soak in panoramic views of the city below (*weather permitting*)
- See Signal Hill and the Castle of Good Hope
- Catch glimpses of City Hall and the Houses of Parliament as you drive through the city
- Take a walking tour of the Bo-Kaap area, home to Cape Malay culture and some of the city's most vibrant architecture
- Visit the District Six Museum to learn about the diverse communities that were forcibly removed under apartheid

- See how the people working at the museum are helping to rebuild the communities and strengthen the rich cultures in District Six and beyond

Please note: On some departures, the optional excursion will be offered in the morning and the sightseeing tour will take place in the afternoon. In the event of inclement weather, the visit to Table Mountain will be moved to day 13 or 14. In the unlikely event of poor weather both days, Table Mountain will be replaced with a visit to Signal Hill.

Spend a free afternoon in Cape Town or add an excursion.

+ Robben Island

Day 13: Sightseeing tour of the Cape Peninsula & choir performance

Included meals: breakfast

Spend the day exploring the Cape Peninsula.

- Drive along the Atlantic seaboard, passing the Clifton and Camp's Bay beaches
- Visit the Cape of Good Hope and the lighthouse at Cape Point to soak in beautiful views of where the Atlantic and Indian oceans meet
- Visit Boulders Beach, a protected marine habitat for the endangered African penguin
- Learn how your visit helps support the Southern African Foundation for the Conservation of Coastal Birds, a local NGO

As you travel back to Cape Town, stop to enjoy a performance by the Major Voices South African Choir.

- Listen to the talented group sing a cappella, Isicathamiya, Afro-gospel, and jazz music
- Watch as they dance along to the songs
- Hear about the group's mission to give youth community members an opportunity to be involved in music and the arts

Day 14: Free day in Cape Town

Included meals: breakfast

Enjoy a free day in Cape Town or add an excursion.

This evening, enjoy a farewell drink as you celebrate your trip with your fellow group members.

Extension excursion options

Day 12: Robben Island

\$119CAD (4 hours, departs in the afternoon)

Today, board a ferry to Robben Island—an enduring reminder of apartheid and South Africa's struggle for freedom. First fortified in the 17th century and used as a jail until 1996, this UNESCO-recognized site imprisoned Nelson Mandela and other political activists and dissidents. There, you'll set off on a tour, guided by a former political prisoner. You'll see the cell where Mandela was held for 18 years, and learn more about the Nobel laureate's life and work. Afterward, take the ferry back to the Victoria & Alfred Waterfront and enjoy free time in the area before ending your outing.

Please note: This excursion is weather-dependent. In case of inclement weather, it will take place on the afternoon of day 4. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 20 days prior to departure.

Day 14: Cape Winelands Tasting & Lunch

\$129CAD/\$139CAD* (6 hours, departs in the morning with lunch)

Leave the city behind for a sensational day in the Cape Winelands—a trio of valleys and the largest winemaking region in South Africa. Depart Cape Town, driving through mountainous, tree-lined terrain, en route to a vineyard in the Stellenbosch Region. Here, you'll get a taste of some of the area's finest vintages—like pinotage, a distinctly South African varietal first created and cultivated in the country. Then, continue to another estate for a second tasting, accompanied by a light lunch. Relax and soak in the scenery, then make your way back to Cape Town.
