## Quito → 3 nights

### Day 1: Flight & late-night arrival in Quito

Welcome to Ecuador! Arrive in Quito late this evening and transfer to your hotel.

### Day 2: Sightseeing tour of Quito

*Included meals: breakfast, welcome lunch*

Today, embark on a guided sightseeing tour of Quito.

- Drive up Cerro Panecillo hill for views of the city and surrounding volcanoes
- Sit down to enjoy an included welcome lunch
- Marvel at the neo-Gothic Basilica of the National Vow
- Enjoy a walking tour of the Old Town, passing by the Legislative Palace, Independence Square, and the Metropolitan Cathedral of Quito
- Enter La Compañía, the city's Baroque church, to view its gold leaf interior
- Step inside the 16th-century Monastery of San Francisco

### Day 3: Free day in Quito

*Included meals: breakfast*

Enjoy a free day in Quito or add an excursion.

## Galápagos Islands → 4 nights

### Day 4: Galápagos cruise & San Cristóbal

*Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner*

Fly to San Cristóbal, the easternmost island of the Galápagos, to board your cruise this morning.

- Enjoy an included lunch aboard the ship
- Disembark and hike to San Cristóbal's Frigatebird Hill for views of the bay, as well as birding opportunities to see the tropical frigatebirds

Sit down for an included dinner this evening.

### Day 5: Española Island

*Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner*

Today, visit Española Island to explore one of the most picture-perfect beaches that the Galápagos has to offer.

- Relax on the white sand beaches and snorkel in the shallow waters just off the shore of Gardner Bay
- Get up-close to the friendly Galápagos sea lions who call the island home
- Look out for mockingbirds, finches, marine life, and more
- Enjoy an included lunch
- Visit Punta Suarez, on the western edge of the island, which is a wildlife hub for boobies, albatross, sea lions, iguanas, and more

Sit down for an included dinner this evening.

### Day 6: Floreana Island

*Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner*

Floreana has something for both history lovers and wildlife enthusiasts.

- Stop at Post Office Bay to visit the oldest operating post office in the Pacific, where whalers used to leave letters to be picked up by returning voyagers
- Enjoy an included lunch
- See flamingos feeding in the lagoon, diamond stingrays swimming offshore, and green sea turtles exploring their nesting grounds in Punta Cormorant
- Explore the volcanic shore of Devil's Crown and snorkel for the chance to see yellowtailed surgeonfish, creolefish, turtles, spotted eagle rays, parrotfish, and hammerhead sharks

- Put on your snorkel and hit the water to get up close to green turtles, harmless whitetip reef sharks, and lots of fish in Champion Islet

Sit down for an included dinner this evening.

### Day 7: Santa Cruz Island

*Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner*

Your day on Santa Cruz Island is all about wildlife and the sensation of being somewhere very few people have ever been.

- Pass a brackish lagoon with your guide and keep your eyes peeled for shore birds and flamingos
- Walk through dry zone vegetation before reaching Dragon Hill, where you'll enjoy panoramic views of the neighboring islands and spot land iguanas
- Enjoy an included lunch aboard your ship

- Relax on the powdery beach at Punta Bowditch during a visit to this recently opened area of the Galápagos
- Explore the salt pools and white coral that surround the water islet

Sit down for an included dinner this evening.

## Otavalo → 1 night

### Day 8: Transfer to Otavalo via Quito

*Included meals: breakfast, farewell dinner*

Disembark the ship to further explore Santa Cruz Island in the Galápagos before making your way to Otavalo, a market town in the Andes Mountains.

- Journey to the Santa Cruz highlands, northwest of Puerto Ayora, to visit a giant tortoise nature reserve
- Walk through the humid forest landscape to see these slow-moving reptiles in action
- Return to Baltra and board your flight back to Quito on the mainland

Celebrate your trip at a farewell dinner this evening.

## Overnight Flight → 1 night

### Day 9: Otavalo market visit & departure

*Included meals: breakfast*

Visit the Otavalo market to browse the stalls, shop for indigenous crafts, and attend a local weaving demonstration. Then, stop to view the Quitsato Sundial, a monument located on the equator, where you'll view a demonstration of equatorial effects.

Afterward, relax in a dayroom before boarding your flight home late tonight or early tomorrow morning.

*Please note: If you're traveling on the tour extension to Peru, you will overnight in Quito.*

### Day 10: Arrival home

*Please note: Due to varying flight schedules, some travelers may depart on the morning of day 10, arriving home later that evening.*

### + Peru extension

Fly to Lima to experience the best Peru has to offer—and, yep, that includes Machu Picchu. Continue your trip to see the legacy of the conquistadors and uncover the Lost City of the Inca, all with your expert Tour Director at your side.

### Quito → 1 night

#### Day 9: Otavalo market visit

*Included meals: breakfast*

After your visit to Otavalo market, enjoy a free afternoon in Quito.

---

### Lima → 1 night

#### Day 10: Flight to Lima

*Included meals: breakfast*

Fly to Lima, Peru this morning and get settled in to your hotel.

---

### Cuzco → 2 nights

#### Day 11: Flight to Cuzco & folklore show

*Included meals: breakfast*

Fly to Cuzco and spend free time getting acclimatized to the city's high elevation. Tonight, get a taste of Peruvian cuisine during an included dinner as you watch a traditional folklore show featuring indigenous dances from around the country.

#### Day 12: Sightseeing tour of Cuzco

*Included meals: breakfast, dinner*

Set out on a sightseeing tour of Cuzco, the UNESCO-recognized ancient capital of the Inca Empire.

- Stroll through ruins at Kenko, the “red fortress” of Puca Pucara and Sacsayhuaman, which was once completely covered in gold
- View the towering Cristo Blanco statue, a thank-you gift from the Palestinian refugees who took shelter in the city during World War II

- Stop at the colonial-era Plaza de Armas to enter Cuzco Cathedral
- Walk through the city center and step inside the Convent of Santo Domingo, built by the Spaniards where the Inca temple of Koricancha stood

Spend a free evening in Cuzco or add an excursion.

### Machu Picchu → 1 night

#### Day 13: Aguas Calientes via the Sacred Valley

*Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner*

Today, you'll transfer to Aguas Calientes, the gateway to Machu Picchu. First, make a stop in the Sacred Valley to see the sights.

- Peruse the colorful stalls of the wide-open Pisac Market, where you'll find local fare and traditional crafts on display
- Enjoy an included lunch in Urubamba
- Continue to the ancient Ollantaytambo ruins to explore still-standing Incan homes
- Board a train to Aguas Calientes

Sit down for an included dinner this evening.

*Please note: Travelers must submit full passport details by Tour Finalization Date or risk being denied entry to Machu Picchu due to scarcity of tickets and daily entrance restrictions.*

### Cuzco → 1 night

#### Day 14: Sightseeing tour of Machu Picchu & train to Cuzco

*Included meals: breakfast, lunch*

On today's guided tour, you'll uncover the lost city of Machu Picchu, one of the most spectacular archaeological sites on the entire South American continent.

- Tour the ruins of the ceremonial center, cultivation terraces and guard house
  - Visit Funeral Rock, the Main Temple, Temple of the Three Windows, Chamber of Ornaments, the Sacred Plaza, the Intihuatana stone, the Temple of the Sun, the Rock Quarry, the Ritual Fountains and the Condor Temple
  - Enjoy an included lunch before taking a scenic train ride back to Cuzco for the night

### Overnight Flight → 1 night

### Day 15: Flight to Lima, sightseeing tour & departure

*Included meals: breakfast, farewell lunch*

Fly to Lima this morning. Then, enjoy a farewell lunch before setting out on a guided tour, which highlights Lima's modern and colonial quarters.

- Visit the Miraflores district and Parque del Amor
- View Plaza Mayor and the Municipal Palace in Lima's historic center
- Enter the Cathedral of Lima and descend into the catacombs below the Church of San Francisco

Later, relax in a dayroom before boarding your overnight flight home.

## Day 3: Antisana Ecological Reserve & Hacienda

### Lunch

\$109/\$119\* (9 hours, departs in the morning, lunch included)

Journey through the valleys of the Andes Mountain range to visit the Antisana Ecological Reserve. This reserve was created in 1993 to protect Ecuadorian wildlife and ecosystems and is home to Antisana volcano, the country's fourth-largest. Join your Tour Director on a walk to see a recent lava flow, snowcapped mountains, and the picturesque views surrounding Lake Mica. Of course, it wouldn't be a nature walk without seeing some of the local flora and fauna. Take part in some bird-watching to try and spot the silvery grebe, black-faced ibis, and elusive Andean condor. Then, enjoy lunch at a local restaurant located on a hacienda, or traditional ranch, before traveling back to Quito.

## Extension excursion options

### Day 12: Peruvian Cooking Demonstration & Dinner

\$125/\$135\* (3 hours, departs in the evening with dinner)

Watch as an expert chef prepares a traditional Peruvian meal during a cooking demonstration at one of Cuzco's top restaurants on this culinary excursion. With the beautiful Andes Mountains as your backdrop, you'll discover how Peruvians use locally sourced ingredients to create authentic dishes. You'll also learn how to make causa de pollo, a dish made of chicken and potatoes, and tiradito de trucha, a popular seafood-based meal. Afterwards, enjoy a delicious three-course dinner crafted by the expert chef in the restaurant.
