Day 2: Arrival in Florence

- Step inside the Accademia Gallery to see
 Michelangelo's iconic statue, the David
 (Please note: Entrance to the Accademia
 Gallery may occur during the afternoon
 instead of the morning on day 3, or may take
 place on days 5 or 6.)
- View the legendary Florence Cathedral, known as the Duomo, and walk through the city's UNESCO-listed Historic Center
- Pass Giotto's Campanile, a masterpiece of Gothic architecture
- See the medieval Ponte Vecchio and the Piazza della Signoria, the center of Florentine life

- View the stately Doge's Palace, built in the Venetian Gothic style in 1340
- Marvel at the Bridge of Sighs, the link between Doge's Palace and the New Prison
- See a glassblowing demonstration to learn about the city's most celebrated art

Day 3: Tuscan Cooking Class & Dinner

\$115 (2.5 hours, departs in the evening with dinner) This evening, learn how to make a traditional Tuscan meal under the direction of expert local chefs. Craft authentic pici, a thick, hand-rolled pasta, two kinds of bruschetta, and tiramisu. Then, pair your creations with wine, and sit down to a delicious dinner with your group. Please note: Depending on the size of the group, the class may be divided into two shifts. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 20 days prior to departure.

Day 4: Siena & Chianti Wine Tasting

\$129/\$139* (8 hours, departs in the morning) Visit the UNESCO-listed Tuscan hilltown of Siena for a guided tour of its medieval sites. Enter the city's 13thcentury cathedral, a Gothic masterpiece. It boasts a 56-panel marble mosaic floor, which was completed over a span of almost 200 years, and which is only displayed in its entirety between August and October each year. Marvel at Pinturicchio's frescoes in the adjoining Piccolomini Library, which was built for Pope Pius II. Delve into the city's most important sport as you stroll through Piazza del Campo, site of the annual Palio horse race. Then, journey to Chianti to learn about Italy's wine culture and tradition of agriturismo. Enjoy picturesque views on a winery tour, then taste three of the winery's most distinctive labels paired with antipasti and crostini

Day 5: Florence Home-Hosted Dinner

\$89 (3 hours, departs in the evening, dinner included)
Join a local at their home in Florence to enjoy traditional
dishes and dine like a true Italian. During this dinner,
you'll receive an authentic understanding of your host's
day-to-day life while learning about Italian culture and
traditions from a new perspective. Please note: Your
Tour Director will not attend this excursion. This
excursion requires advance reservation and must be
booked at least 20 days prior to departure.

Day 5: Michelangelo's Florence

\$95/\$105* (4 hours, departs in the morning)
Unravel the genius of Michelangelo, the famous painter, architect, and poet, as you tour notable museums throughout Florence. Start with the San Lorenzo complex, viewing the basilica's counter façade and the Medici Chapels, where you can admire his magnificent sculptures and the architecture in the Laurentian Library vestibule. Walk by Palazzo Medici Riccardi and continue on to enter the Museo dell'Opera del Duomo to see the famous Pietà sculpture and the original Gate of Paradise. On a walking tour of the city, pass the Bargello National Museum and the Buonarroti House, once owned by the artist himself. End the tour outside of the Basilica of Santa Croce, site of Michelangelo's tomb.

Day 6: The Pitti Palace & the Boboli Gardens

\$105/\$115* (4 hours, departs in the morning)

Cross the Arno River for a guided tour of the Pitti Palace, the Medici family's 16th-century residence. Today, it's distinguished as a world-class art museum and houses several lavish galleries including the Palatine Gallery. This gallery once served as the Grand Dukes' living quarters and still houses the Medici's private collection of artwork by notable figures such as Titian, Raphael and Rubens. The museum is also home to the Modern Art Gallery, which holds 30 rooms of works that span the 18th century to the early 20th century. After seeing the artwork, step outside to enjoy free time exploring the hilltop Boboli Gardens, which offer incredible, sweeping views of Florence.

Extension excursion options

Day 8: Gondola Ride: Venice Canal Cruise

\$89/\$99* (25 minutes, departure time varies)
More than 100 canals crisscross Venice, and boarding a sleek, black gondola to explore them has become a time-honored tradition. On this memorable excursion, join your fellow travelers for a tour through the canals of Venice, with a gondolier deftly guiding your boat along. Please note: This excursion runs as weather permits, and travelers should feel comfortable getting into and out of the gondolas. A private, two-person gondola ride is available for an additional cost.

Day 8: Private Gondola Ride: Canal Cruise for Two

\$165/\$175* (25 minutes, departure time varies)
More than 100 canals crisscross Venice, and boarding a sleek, black gondola to explore them has become a time-honored tradition. On this memorable excursion, you'll enjoy a private gondola cruise for two through the canals of Venice, with a gondolier deftly guiding your boat along.

Please note: This excursion requires two passengers. Cost is per person, and each traveler must book the excursion. Travelers should also feel comfortable getting into and out of the gondolas. This excursion runs as weather permits.

Day 9: Islands of the Venetian Lagoon: Burano & Torcello

\$85/\$95* (5 hours, departure time varies)
Visit the islands of the Venetian lagoon, a favorite day trip for locals and travelers alike. First travel by water taxi to Torcello, where the story of Venice began. It was here that mainlanders sought a safe haven from invading barbarians. Step inside the Basilica of Santa Maria Assunta, whose famous mosaics depict The Last Judgement. The next stop is the tiny fishing village of Burano, where brightly colored homes greet visitors. Wander as you please throughout Burano, and be sure to stop in at the island's bakeries.
