



Historic Germany: Berlin to Bavaria

12 days | 15 days with Vienna extension

Take a step back in time as you wander along the medieval streets of Rothenburg ob der Tauber before ending in Munich, the capital of Bavarian food and culture.

Day 1: Travel day

Board your overnight flight to Berlin today.

Berlin \rightarrow 3 nights

Day 2: Arrival in Berlin

Included meals: welcome dinner
Welcome to Germany! Meet your fellow
travelers at tonight's welcome dinner.

Day 3: Sightseeing tour of Berlin

Included meals: breakfast

A local guide introduces you to the monuments of Berlin's intricate past as well as the signs of its re-emergence as a vibrant cultural center.

- Discover the Brandenburg Gate, the symbol of a reunited Berlin
- See the Holocaust Memorial and the Berlin Wall's East Side Gallery
- Journey down Unter den Linden, the city's most elegant boulevard, passing the Reichstag and Museum Island

Enjoy a free afternoon in Berlin or add an excursion.

+ World War II Walking Tour

Day 4: Potsdam

Included meals: breakfast

Travel to Potsdam, where American, British, and Soviet leaders drew up plans for the postwar administration of Germany at the Potsdam Conference.

- Explore the historic town center, New Garden, and Dutch Quarter with a guide
- Step inside Cecilienhof Palace, site of the Potsdam Conference's iconic photo

Dresden → 2 nights

Day 5: Sightseeing tour of Dresden

Included meals: breakfast, dinner
Leave Berlin for a guided tour of Dresden, once
considered to be the most beautiful city in the
world.

- Stroll through the Old Town and pass the renovated Semper Opera House, site of the Saxon State Orchestra
- Admire the Dresden Frauenkirche and statue
 of Martin Luther
- See the Zwinger Palace, a striking example of Baroque architecture, and walk through the palace gardens

This evening, sit down to an included dinner with your group.

Day 6: Free day in Dresden

Included meals: breakfast
Spend a full free day in Dresden or add an excursion.

+ Görlitz

Bamberg → 2 nights

Day 7: Bamberg via Weimar

Included meals: breakfast, dinner
Travel to Bamberg by way of Weimar, the
UNESCO-listed intellectual hub that nurtured the
genius of Goethe, Nietzsche, and Schiller.

- Learn about the city's literary history on a walking tour through the Old Town
- See remnants of the Bauhaus architectural movement
- Discover the German National Theatre and its monument to Goethe and Schiller

Then, continue on to Bamberg where you'll sit down to an included dinner with your group. (Please note: Some departures may overnight in Würzburg, Bayreuth, or Coburg instead of Bamberg.)

Day 8: Sightseeing tour of Bamberg

Included meals: breakfast
Set off with a local guide on a walking tour
through Bamberg, a city built on seven hills.

- Enter the towering Bamberg Cathedral and surrounding square
- Pass the Baroque New Palace
- Stand in awe of Old Town Hall, built in the middle of Regnitz River
- Visit the quaint fisherman's village of Little Venice

Enjoy a free afternoon in Bamberg or add an excursion.

Day 9: Munich via Rothenburg ob der Tauber

Included meals: breakfast

Set off for Munich, stopping en route in Rothenburg ob der Tauber for a sightseeing tour of the town's picturesque squares.

Enjoy a free evening in Munich or add an excursion.

+ Bavarian Brewery & Beer Tasting

Day 10: Sightseeing tour of Munich

Included meals: breakfast

Get to know the Bavarian capital on a guided tour.

- Travel past the Englischer Garten and fashionable Schwabing district
- Enter the Nymphenburg Palace, the Baroque home to past Bavarian royalty
- Walk from Odeonsplatz through the nearby Hofgarten to view the Residenz, once home to the Wittelsbach dukes of Bavaria
- Explore Marienplatz, Munich's medieval heart, and see the famed Glockenspiel

Day 11: Free day in Munich

Included meals: breakfast, farewell dinner Spend a full free day in Munich or add an excursion.

Day 12: Vienna via Salzburg

Included meals: breakfast

Pass through the Austrian countryside, stopping to explore Salzburg on your own en route to Vienna.

Day 13: Sightseeing tour of Vienna

Included meals: breakfast

Get transported back to the Age of Empires on a guided tour of Vienna.

- Travel down the Ringstrasse to the Parliament building and the Vienna State Opera
- View the impressive art collection inside the Kunsthistorisches Museum
- See the grand Hofburg Palace, the Hapsburg's preferred winter residence

Day 3: World War II Walking Tour

79/\$89* (5 hours, departs in the afternoon, lunch included)

Take a walk through history on this insider's tour of Berlin during World War II, detailing the rise and fall of Hitler and the Third Reich. You'll start in the Wilhelmstrasse area and see the building that once housed the headquarters of Hermann Goering's Luftwaffe. You'll also view the former headquarters of the infamous SS and Gestapo, the massive Reich Chancellery, and the Propaganda Ministry. Finally, stand directly above Hitler's Führerbunker as your guide details the last days of World War II in Europe. Lunch is included.

Day 6: Görlitz

\$115/\$125* (7 hours, departs in the morning, lunch included)

Until 1945, the modern-day towns of Zgorzelec, Poland, and Görlitz, Germany, were a single entity. In their current separated state, each town offers unique insights into their nations' shared history. Enjoy an included lunch in Zgorzelec, and then cross the bridge over the Neisse River onto the Germany side. Here, a local guide gives you a tour of Görlitz, including a visit to the Church of St. Peter and Paul.

Day 8: Historic Nuremberg

\$105 (6 hours, departs in the afternoon) Step into history as you set off on a guided tour of Nuremburg, Bavaria's second-largest city. The destination has something for history buffs, foodies, and culture lovers. Begin your visit by Palace of Justice. You'll enter the Memorium Nuremberg Trials museum and see Courtroom 600, where the infamous Nuremburg Trials took place after World War II. Then, follow your Tour Director on a tour of the city's charming, walled Old Town. In the winter, the Old Town is home to one of the oldest Christmas markets in Germany. But even when it's not the holiday season, there's plenty to discover. Admire the traditional Bavarian architecture, walk along the Pegnitz River, or pop into a local shop to try some local beer or gingerbread cookies during your free time. Please note: Court Room 600 may be closed when trials are in session. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 20 days prior to departure.

Day 9: Bavarian Brewery & Beer Tasting

\$105/\$115* (4 hours, departs in the afternoon)
Make your way to a traditional Bavarian brewery and
take a guided tour. Then, enjoy a tasting of some of
Germany's most famous brews. This region of the
country produces a variety of beers including Helles,
light lagers, Weissbier (a trendy type of wheat beer),
and Pils, the most well-known and widely produced
style.

Day 10: Dachau

\$55/\$65* (4 hours, departs in the afternoon)

Once a typical German town, Dachau served as the first Nazi concentration camp during World War II. Visit this somber site, which has since been transformed into a Holocaust memorial museum that serves as a testament to the strength of the human spirit. You'll take a self-guided audio tour through Dachau's poignant exhibits, which are echoed by the memorials to the victims that adorn the grounds.

Day 11: Bavarian Castle Visit

\$95 (9 hours, departs in the morning) Head into the mountains of Bavaria to visit the regal Hohenschwangau Castle, the childhood home of Bavaria's Mad King Ludwig II. Start with a photo stop at the fairy-tale Neuschwanstein Castle, which is believed to be the inspiration for Disneyland's castle. Then, transfer to nearby Hohenschwangau Castle for a guided tour of its rooms, such as the Drinking Hall, which has been turned into a chapel. View beautiful wall and ceiling murals illustrating German Folklore and medieval legends, and don't forget to keep an eye out for the all the homages to swans. They're the symbolic animal of the king's family. Please note: On some departures, a shuttle bus may be offered to take travelers up the hill to Neuschwanstein for a closer look. When shuttles are not running, the path to the castle is mostly paved road, but it's steep and the walk can take approximately 20-30 minutes. Winter months are prone to inclement weather, in the event of which shuttle buses might not run. This means the walk to the castle may be slippery and covered in snow. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 20 days prior to departure.

Extension excursion options

Day 13: Traditional Viennese Heurigen Evening

\$119/\$129* (4 hours, departs in the evening, dinner included)

After a brief drive, your first stop is Vienna's Prater Ferris Wheel. Take a breezy ride to the top, which offers a one-of-a-kind view of the city. Next, continue on to a picturesque village and sit down at local restaurant where you'll indulge in a festive night of music, food, and entertainment. Dinner will feature dishes typical of traditional Austrian Heurigens, or wine taverns. During your meal, you'll have the chance to try some of the tavern's own locally made wine—the perfect addition to your cozy, Old-World setting.

Day 14: Danube River Cruise & Melk Abbey

\$139/\$149* (9 hours, departs in the morning)
Travel to Melk to take a guided tour of the UNESCOlisted Melk Abbey. This architectural wonder is perched
high atop a cliff and is one of Europe's most beautiful
Baroque monasteries. Then, embark on a leisurely
cruise down the Danube River where you'll pass age-old
castles and picturesque villages. Disembark in
Dürnstein, where Richard the Lionheart was held
captive, and enjoy free time to explore. En route to

Vienna, stop in the Wachau Valley for a wine tasting of regional vintages. Please note: This excursion is seasonal and runs from April through October.
