Day 1: Travel day

Board your overnight flight to Munich today.

Munich → 2 nights

Day 2: Arrival in Munich

Included meals: dinner

Welcome to Germany! Meet your Tour Director and fellow travelers at tonight's welcome dinner.

Day 3: Sightseeing tour of Munich

Included meals: breakfast

Get to know the Bavarian capital on a guided tour.

- Travel past the Englischer Garten and fashionable Schwabing district
- Enter the Nymphenburg Palace, the Baroque home to past Bavarian royalty
- Walk from Odeonsplatz through the Hofgarten to view the Residenz, once home to the Wittelsbach dukes of Bavaria
- Explore Marienplatz, Munich's medieval heart, and see the famed Glockenspiel

Spend a free afternoon in Munich or add an excursion.

+ Dachau

Oberammergau → 1 night

Day 4: Passion Play

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner

Head to Oberammergau and attend the 42nd performance of the world-famous Passion Play.

- Experience the storytelling and portrayal of the Old and New Testament that has taken place once a decade since 1634
- Enjoy the unforgettable open-air performance put on by the residents of the Bavarian town

Sit down for an included dinner this evening.

Bamberg → 2 nights

Day 5: Bamberg via Hohenschwangau Castle

Included meals: breakfast, dinner

On your way to Bamberg, travel through the Bavarian Alps making several stops along the way.

- Make a photo stop at Neuschwanstein Castle, the fairy-tale retreat of "Mad" King Ludwig II
- Revel in scenic views of the Alps as you relax during free time for lunch in the town below Neuschwanstein
- Enter Hohenschwangau Castle, the former summer and hunting residence of the Bavarian royal family

After, continue on to Bamberg and sit down for an included dinner.

Day 6: Sightseeing tour of Bamberg

Included meals: breakfast

Set off on a guided walking tour through Bamberg, a city built on seven hills.

- Enter the towering Bamberg Cathedral and surrounding square
- Pass the Baroque New Palace
- Stand in awe of Old Town Hall, built in the middle of Regnitz River
- Visit the quaint fisherman's village of Little Venice

Spend a free afternoon in Bamberg or add an excursion.

+ Rothenburg

Dresden → 2 nights

Day 7: Dresden via Weimar

Included meals: breakfast, dinner

On your way to Dresden, stop in Weimar and take a guided tour of the UNESCO-listed intellectual hub that nurtured the genius of Goethe, Nietzsche, and Schiller.

- Learn about the city's literary history on a walking tour through the Old Town
- See remnants of the Bauhaus architectural movement
- Discover the German National Theatre and its monument to Goethe and Schiller
- Enjoy free time for lunch

Continue on to Dresden and sit down for an included dinner.

Day 8: Sightseeing tour of Dresden

Included meals: breakfast

Set off on a guided tour of Dresden, once considered to be the most beautiful city in the world.

- Stroll through the Old Town and pass the renovated Semper Opera House, site of the Saxon State Orchestra
- Admire the Dresden Frauenkirche and statue of Martin Luther

Spend a free afternoon in Dresden or add an excursion.

+ Görlitz

Berlin → 3 nights

Day 9: Transfer to Berlin & sightseeing tour

Included meals: breakfast

Travel to Berlin, where a local guide introduces you to the monuments of the city's intricate past as well as the signs of its re-emergence as a vibrant cultural center.

- Discover the Brandenburg Gate, the symbol of a reunited Berlin
- See the Holocaust Memorial and the Berlin Wall's East Side Gallery
- Journey down Unter den Linden, the city's most elegant boulevard, passing the Reichstag and Museum Island

Day 10: Free day in Berlin

Included meals: breakfast

Spend a free day in Berlin or add an excursion.

+ World War II Walking Tour

Day 11: Sightseeing tour of Potsdam

Included meals: breakfast, farewell dinner

Travel to Potsdam, where American, British, and Soviet leaders drew up plans for the postwar administration of Germany at the Potsdam Conference.

- Step inside Cecilienhof Palace, site of the Potsdam Conference's iconic photo
- Explore the historic town center, New Garden, and Dutch Quarter with a guide
- Enjoy free time for lunch before returning to Berlin

This evening, gather with your group for a farewell dinner.

Flight Home

Day 12: Departure

Included meals: breakfast (excluding early morning departures)

Transfer to the airport for your flight home or extend your tour in Prague, Czech Republic.

Continue your trip to learn why Prague is the City of One Hundred Spires. (Hint: There are a lot of spires, and it's a really beautiful place.) You'll also uncover some amazing history as you explore the Czech capital with a local guide.

Day 12: Transfer to Prague

Included meals: breakfast

Make your way to Prague, Czech Republic.

Day 13: Sightseeing tour of Prague

Included meals: breakfast

Discover why Prague is known as the City of One Hundred Spires on a guided sightseeing tour.

- Visit Prague Castle, from which Charles IV governed the Holy Roman Empire
- Admire the soaring Gothic vaults of St. Vitus Cathedral
- Ride a tram from Castle Hill down to the Vltava River
- Cross the elegant Charles Bridge for breathtaking views of the city
- Stroll through Old Town Square to view the 15th-century Astronomical Clock

Day 3: Dachau

\$55/\$65* (4 hours, departs in the afternoon)

Once a typical German town, Dachau served as the first Nazi concentration camp during World War II. Visit this somber site, which has since been transformed into a Holocaust memorial museum that serves as a testament to the strength of the human spirit. You'll take a self-guided audio tour through Dachau's poignant exhibits, which are echoed by the memorials to the victims that adorn the grounds.

Day 6: Rothenburg

\$59/\$69* (6 hours, departs in the afternoon)

Visit Rothenburg, the most well-preserved walled Medieval town in Germany. Upon arrival, join a local guide and embark on a sightseeing tour of the city. You'll stop at the Town Hall, the Medieval Crime and Punishment Museum, and St. Jakob's Church, where you'll see a 500-year-old, hand-carved, wooden altarpiece.

Day 8: Görlitz

\$115/\$125* (7 hours, departs in the morning, lunch included)

Until 1945, the modern-day towns of Zgorzelec, Poland, and Görlitz, Germany, were a single entity. In their current separated state, each town offers unique insights into their nations' shared history. Enjoy an included lunch in Zgorzelec, and then cross the bridge over the Neisse River onto the Germany side. Here, a local guide gives you a tour of Görlitz, including a visit to the Church of St. Peter and Paul.

Day 10: World War II Walking Tour

\$79/\$89* (5 hours, departs in the afternoon, lunch included)

Take a walk through history on this insider's tour of Berlin during World War II, detailing the rise and fall of Hitler and the Third Reich. You'll start in the Wilhelmstrasse area and see the building that once housed the headquarters of Hermann Goering's Luftwaffe. You'll also view the former headquarters of the infamous SS and Gestapo, the massive Reich Chancellery, and the Propaganda Ministry. Finally, stand directly above Hitler's Führerbunker as your guide details the last days of World War II in Europe. Lunch is included.

Extension excursion options

Day 14: Walking Tour of Prague's Jewish Quarter

\$115/\$125* (3.5 hours, departs in the afternoon, lunch included)

Head to Josefov, Prague's Jewish Quarter, nestled between the Vltava River and Old Town Square. You'll enjoy a lunch of regional specialties at a nearby restaurant and join a local guide for a walking tour of the Quarter's remains, which survived devastation during World War II and oppression during the Communist era. Afterward, pay a visit to the Jewish Museum of Prague,

housed in a collection of former synagogues, one of which displays the names of all the Czechs sent to concentration camps. You'll learn about the Golem myth, a story forever entwined with Prague's Jewish history, and see sites once frequented by Franz Kafka, the enigmatic author of "The Trial" and "Metamorphosis." Please note: This excursion involves a significant amount of walking and standing. On some departures, this excursion will begin with the walking tour of the Jewish Quarter and end with lunch at a local restaurant.

Day 14: Château Sychrov

\$159/\$169* (6 hours, departs in the afternoon, dinner included)

Head into the Czech countryside for an experience exclusively available to Go Ahead travelers. Built in the classic Neo-Gothic style, the 17th-century Château Sychrov is an aristocratic residence owned by the Rohan family for over 200 years. You'll step inside the opulent château after it closes to the general public. Soak in the beauty of the castle on a private tour, admiring the colorful walls, intricate wood carvings on the ceilings, and built-in furniture as you make your way through the rooms. From the beds to the bureaus, each area of the castle has perfectly preserved pieces of 19th-century decor on display. See famous paintings of French royalty and the Rohan family while learning about their daring escape from persecution in France. After you finish touring the manicured grounds, head to the on-site restaurant. Here, you'll attend a private recital of classic Czech music performed by some of Prague's most talented musicians and enjoy a private dinner featuring regional specialties and local beer or wine. Please note: This excursion runs from January through mid October. The château does not have heat or air conditioning, therefore we recommend dressing accordingly based on the season. When the Orangerie is closed, dinner will served in a different wing of the Château.

*Optional excursions may be purchased up to three days prior to departure or while on tour. Pre-purchased optional excursions cannot be canceled within three days prior to departure or while on tour.
