




Hawaii: Oahu, the Big Island & Maui

Honolulu, Oahu \rightarrow 3 nights

Day 1: Arrival in Honolulu

Included meals: welcome dinner Welcome to Hawaii! Arrive in Honolulu and

transfer to your hotel in Waikiki.

Tonight, sit down to a welcome dinner with your group.

Day 2: Sightseeing tour of Oahu

Included meals: breakfast

This morning, explore Polynesian culture and visit Pearl Harbor, the site of the surprise military attack that led to the United States' entry to WWII.

- Stop by the Bernice Pauahi Bishop Museum to learn about Hawaiian culture.
- View a short film on the site's tragic history at the Pearl Harbor Memorial Theater.
- Take a short boat ride to the USS Arizona memorial site for a one-hour guided tour (*weather permitting*).

Head toward Oahu's eastern shore for a guided sightseeing of the island.

- Stop at Nu'uanu Pali, where Kamehameha I fought to conquer Oahu.
- Try to spot the island of Molokai in the distance from Makapu'u Point.
- Pass by beautiful Hanauma Bay to see Halona Blowhole and the surrounding natural rock formations.
- Take in views of Diamond Head, the island's towering volcanic ash cone.

Please note: The order of activities is subject to change. Due to dock damage and other on-site restrictions the boat taxi to the USS Arizona is not guaranteed.

Day 3: Free day in Honolulu

Included meals: breakfast

Spend a free day on Oahu or add excursions.

$\textbf{Hilo, Hawaii} \rightarrow 1 \text{ night}$

Day 4: Flight to Hilo & sightseeing tour

Included meals: breakfast This morning, board your flight to Hilo, the largest city on the Big Island. Then, join your Tour Director to explore the city.

- See Waianuenue Falls, a roaring waterfall where visitors can often spot a rainbow in the surrounding mist.
- Walk through Liliuokalani Park and Gardens to see the Japanese style architectural elements.
- View Coconut Island.
- Walk through the local marketplace where you'll have free time to visit some of the shops.

Enjoy a free afternoon to explore Hilo.

Kona, Hawaii \rightarrow 2 nights

Day 5: Hawaii Volcanoes National Park & Pu'uhonua O Honaunau National Historical Park visits

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, tasting En route to Kona, head south to discover some of the island's most beautiful parks.

- Peer into the Kilauea Caldera, the island's most active volcano and is said to be the home of Pele, the Hawaiian Goddess of Fire.
- Enjoy an included lunch at a local restaurant.
- Stop at Punalu'u Beach to try to spot turtles sunning themselves on the black, sandy shores.
- Step into a local coffee shop for a tasting of the island's famous coffee.
- Enter the Pu'uhonua o Honaunau National Historical Park, one of the most sacred *heiau* (places of worship) on the islands.

Day 6: Free day in Kona

Included meals: breakfast, dinner Spend a free day in Kona or add an excursion. Sit down for an included dinner at an authentic Hawaiian luau this evening.

Ka'anapali, Maui \rightarrow 3 nights

Day 7: Flight to Maui

Included meals: breakfast After a quick flight to Maui, transfer to Ka`anapali. Enjoy a free time for the rest of the day to explore the island at your leisure. Please note: Depending on flight availability, the flight to Maui may take place in either the morning or afternoon.

Day 8: Haleakala National Park visit

Included meals: breakfast, lunch Experience the culture and customs of Maui's southeastern side.

- Stop at the Haleakalā National Park Visitor Center, located 9,740 feet above sea level, to view the impressive crater.
- Enjoy an included barbecue lunch.
- Visit a farm on the slopes of Haleakala, where the higher elevation allows for a wider variety of crops and spectacular views of Maui and the ocean.
- Sample fresh goat cheese and learn about it's production.

Day 9: Free day on Maui

Included meals: breakfast, farewell dinner Enjoy a full free day on Maui or add an excursion. This evening, rejoin your group to celebrate your trip with a farewell dinner.

Day 10: Departure

Day 11: Arrive home

Arrive home this morning.

+ Kauai extension

Nicknamed the Garden Island, Kauai is covered in lush rainforest and rolling volcanic landscapes that beg to be explored. It's also known as the most laid-back of all the islands and home to the breathtaking Waimea Canyon.

Day 10: Flight to Kauai

Included meals: breakfast Fly to Kauai this morning and settle in to your hotel.

Day 11: Free day in Kauai

Included meals: breakfast Enjoy a free day to soak in the sun on Kauai's stunning beaches or explore the island at your leisure.

Day 12: Waimea Canyon & Hanapepe Valley

Included meals: breakfast, lunch Learn the incredible natural history of Kauai, Hawaii's oldest and greenest island.

- Visit Waimea Canyon, the "Grand Canyon of Hawaii," and see its incredible valleys from multiple vantage points.
- Stop in the historic town of Koloa where commercial sugar production got its start before spreading to the other islands.
- View the Spouting Horn blowhole and enjoy an included lunch in Poipu.
- After an included lunch, head to Hanapepe Valley Lookout for incredible views the lush valley and dramatic mountains.

Day 13: Departure

Included meals: breakfast Enjoy a free morning in Kauai before transferring to the airport for your flight home.

Day 14: Arrive home Arrive home today.

Day 3: Honolulu Sunset Cruise & Dinner

\$175 (2-3 hours, departs in the evening, dinner included)

Board Hawaii's largest sunset cruise ship for an evening of classic Hawaiian entertainment and hospitality. You'll start your evening with a welcome hula performance at the pier before boarding the luxury ship, where you can explore more than four floors of walk-around decks and a 60-foot high observation deck. While on board you'll be treated to traditional Hawaiian performances and hula dancing as well as a three-course crab, steak, and BBQ chicken dinner. Take in the sunset and beautiful views while sipping on a signature Mai Tai before returning to shore and heading back to the hotel. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 20 days prior to departure.

Day 3: Outrigger Canoe Experience

\$75 (1 hour, departs in the morning)

Take to the water this morning as you meet up with Waikiki's famous beach boys and experience the ways of the ancient Hawaiians aboard an outrigger canoe. After reviewing safety information, hop aboard the canoe and work together to wade out in the water and catch some waves back to shore. Then, enjoy free time on the beach or head back to the hotel. Please note: We recommend wearing a bathing suit, sunscreen, hat and/ or sunglasses, and bringing a towel. Travelers must be able to physically able enter and exit the knee-level canoe without the aid of a ladder or step stool and be able to paddle continuously with your crew through waves and choppy waters. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 20 days prior to departure.

Day 6: Kealakekua Catamaran Cruise & Snorkeling

\$185 (5.5 hours, departs in the morning with lunch) Kealakekua Bay may very well be Hawaii's premier snorkeling destination, thanks to its natural wind protection, remote location, and dazzling marine life. Sip famous Kona coffee and nibble on an included continental breakfast as your catamaran departs from Keauhou Bay and cruises toward Kealakekua Bay State Historical Park. The boat will anchor in the bay so you can enjoy the ship's amenities, or snorkel in the warm waters. Enjoy a buffet style lunch aboard the ship of sandwiches, salad and more with beer, wine and spirits available for purchase. Please note: Bring a towel. sunscreen, and change of clothes if you plan to swim or snorkel. Storage will be available on the boat. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 20 days prior to departure.

Day 9: Maui Chocolate Tour & Tasting

\$139 (1.5 hours, departs in the morning) Start your morning with a visit to a chocolate factory. There, you'll learn about the production of chocolate, from sorting cacao beans by hand to roasting, milling, tempering, and more. Afterward, head into the foothills of the West Maui Mountains and visit a private 20-acre cacao estate. With a local guide you'll set off on a "farm to bar" interactive tour that takes you through the process of growing, harvesting, and production. Cap off your day with a tasting of a variety of award-winning chocolates. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 20 days prior to departure.

*Optional excursions may be purchased up to three days prior to departure or while on tour. Pre-purchased optional excursions cannot be canceled within three days prior to departure or while on tour. Select optional excursions require advance booking and cannot be purchased or canceled after the advanced reservation deadline.
