Day 1: Travel day

Board your overnight flight to Amsterdam today.

Amsterdam → 3 nights

Day 2: Arrival in Amsterdam

Included meals: welcome dinner
Welcome to the Netherlands! Meet your Tour
Director and fellow travelers at tonight's
welcome dinner.

Day 3: Sightseeing tour of Amsterdam

Included meals: breakfast

Today's walking sightseeing tour introduces you to Amsterdam's iconic canals and unique character.

- Begin the day in Rokin with a stop at the Bloemenmarkt, the city's famous flower market
- Then, make a stop at a local cheese stop to explore a variety of local cheeses
- Stroll by the canals and bridges, taking in the houseboats that dot the banks
- Enter the Van Gogh Museum to admire the largest collection of Vincent Van Gogh's masterpieces, including the famous Sunflowers.

Please note: You'll be divided into groups of 20 people or less for the walking portion of the sightseeing tour. Each group will have their own local guide.

Hamburg \rightarrow 2 nights

Day 5: Transfer to Hamburg

Included meals: breakfast, dinner

Journey from the Netherlands to Hamburg, Germany. Then, sit down for an included dinner this evening.

Day 6: Sightseeing tour of Hamburg

Included meals: breakfast

Join a local expert on a guided tour of Hamburg, Germany's second largest city.

- Pass by the neo-Renaissance Rathaus, the city hall
- Admire St. Michaelis Church, the largest Baroque church in northern Germany, and stroll the historic warehouse district

Copenhagen \rightarrow 2 nights

Day 7: Ferry to Copenhagen

Included meals: breakfast, dinner
Travel to Puttgarden, where you'll board a ferry
to cross the Fehmarn Belt and arrive in
Copenhagen, Denmark. This evening, sit down
for an included dinner.

Day 8: Sightseeing tour of Copenhagen

Included meals: breakfast

Take a guided tour of the bustling maritime city with a local guide.

- Step inside the 16th-century Rosenborg
 Castle, a royal residence built in the Dutch
 Renaissance style
- View the iconic Little Mermaid statue and marvel at the wharfside homes and stores in the beautifully preserved Nyhavn district
- Pass by the Amalienborg Palace and Christiansborg Palace, seat of the Danish Parliament

Stockholm → 2 nights

Day 9: Flight to Stockholm

Included meals: breakfast
Fly to Stockholm, Sweden this morning.

Day 10: Sightseeing tour of Stockholm

Included meals: breakfast, farewell dinner

Explore Sweden's sophisticated capital on a guided tour led by a local expert.

- Enter the architecturally unique Stockholm
 City Hall, site of the annual Nobel Prize
 banquet
- Step inside the Vasa Museum to see a 1628 warship that once sat at the bottom of Stockholm harbor
- Stroll through the medieval Old Town and view the Baroque Royal Palace

Enjoy a free afternoon in Stockholm or add an excursion.

Celebrate your trip with your fellow travelers at a farewell dinner this evening.

Day 11: Departure

Included meals: breakfast (excluding early morning departures)

Transfer to the airport for your flight home or extend your stay to visit Norway.

+ Norwegian Fjords extension

There's one word you could use to describe seeing the midnight sun during summer nights, or coasting through fjords flanked by hundred-foot-high cliffs. It's "wow." Fly to Bergen and tour Norway's prettiest places to see what we mean.

Bergen \rightarrow 3 nights

Day 11: Flight to Bergen

Included meals: breakfast

Fly to Bergen, Norway, known as "the gateway to the fjords."

Day 12: Sightseeing tour of Bergen

Included meals: breakfast

Join a local guide to discover historic sites in and around Bergen.

- Drive to Fana and enter the wooden, medieval-style Fantoft Stave Church
- Pass by Bergenhus Fortress and the bustling fish and flower market

- Admire views of the city center and harbor from Custom House Pier
- Walk through the Hanseatic era alleyways and courtyards in the UNESCO-listed Bryggen harbor district

Day 13: Norwegian fjords

Included meals: breakfast

Spend the day journeying through Norway's fjord country, a region of otherworldly natural beauty.

- Take a scenic train ride from Bergen to Voss, where you'll continue on to the village of Gudvangen
- Embark on a cruise through the country's steep cliffs and narrow waterways
- Disembark in the village of Flåm, overlooking Aurlandsfjord

This evening, enjoy a farewell drink as you celebrate your trip with your fellow group members.

Flight Home

Day 14: Departure

Included meals: breakfast (excluding early morning departures)

Transfer to the airport for your flight home.

Day 3: Canal Cruise & Dinner

\$179CAD/\$189CAD* (3 hours, departs in the evening with dinner)

Cruise along the canals of Amsterdam on a houseboat, enjoying the view of row houses lit up for the night. Your cruise will take you through the center of the city as you enjoy dinner by lantern light.

Day 4: A Day in Charming Delft

\$175CAD/\$185CAD* (8 hours, departs in the morning)
Pay a visit to the world-famous flower market at
Aalsmeer for a close-up look at one of Holland's best-known national exports: its brilliantly hued tulips.
Continue to Delft, a charming town of canals, cobbled alleyways and medieval architecture. Visit the Old and
New Churches on a guided tour, and then enjoy free time to grab lunch and explore the town, perhaps visiting the former home of the famous painter,
Vermeer. Please note: A visit to the Hague will replace the flower market on days when the market is closed.

Day 6: Hanseatic Lubeck

\$89CAD/\$99CAD* (5 hours, departs in the afternoon) Discover soaring spires and deep-rooted history as you explore UNESCO-listed Lübeck on a guided tour. This Baltic port served as the capital of the Hanseatic League from the 13th to the 16th century, and remnants from its powerful merchant past still abound throughout the medieval Old Town. Pass through the 15th-century Holstentor gate into the heart of the city where you'll see the Rathaus, or city hall, and explore the Gothic-style St. Mary's Church, one of the largest churches in Germany. Enter a local confectioner's shop to enjoy a tasting of marzipan, a local specialty invented in Lubeck. Then, enjoy free time to explore—and perhaps try some famous German beer.

Day 10: Drottningholm

\$185CAD/\$195CAD* (4 hours, departure time varies)
Take a tranquil ferry ride across Lake Mälaren, and arrive
at Lovön Island, where you'll explore the 16th-century
Drottningholm Palace. The magnificence of this royal
residence, still the permanent residence of Swedish
royalty, rivals that of Versailles. Join a local guide for a
tour of the UNESCO-listed palace to learn about its
storied history and see the decadent rococo interiors.
Please note: This excursion is seasonal and runs from
mid-May to end of August.
