### Day 2: Arrival in Lisbon

- View the outside of the church at Jerónimos Monastery, built to honor voyagers
- Transfer to the bustling Time Out Market for a walk among its stalls and to enjoy free time for lunch

## Seville → 3 nights

### Day 5: Seville via Évora

*Included meals: breakfast, dinner*

Travel through the unspoiled countryside of Portugal en route to Spain. Before crossing the border, stop in Évora to follow a local guide through the Church of St. Francis, known as the "Chapel of Bones."

Later, arrive in Seville, a city brimming with traditional Spanish charm, and sit down for an included dinner.

### Day 6: Sightseeing tour of Seville

*Included meals: breakfast*

Uncover the beauty of Seville, the historic Andalusian capital, on a guided sightseeing tour.

- View the tiled pavilion of the Plaza de España
- Pass the whitewashed homes of Barrio de Santa Cruz
- See the Gothic Seville Cathedral, the third-largest church in the world
- Enter the Royal Alcázar, a palace that was once home to King Ferdinand and Queen Isabella

## Madrid → 3 nights

### Day 8: Madrid via olive oil farm & Córdoba

*Included meals: breakfast*

Leave Seville and make your way to Madrid, stopping en route to discover some of the flavors and history of Andalusia.

- Stop at an olive oil farm and join a local guide for a tour of the olive groves, mill, and cellar
- Sample some orange-infused olive oil drizzled on top of chocolate gelato
- Enjoy free time to shop
- Stop in the town of Córdoba, which was once home to 700 mosques, 900 public baths, and 70 libraries
- Enter the Mezquita, a UNESCO World Heritage site built in the eighth century as a mosque and then transformed into a cathedral during the Christian Reconquista of 1236

Later, board a high-speed train and arrive in Madrid this afternoon.

*Please note: Porterage is not included for the train transfers. Travelers must be comfortable lifting and carrying all luggage over steps, onto platforms, and into luggage storage.*

### Day 9: Sightseeing tour of Madrid

*Included meals: breakfast*

Explore the Spanish capital's beautiful architecture, lively squares, and grand boulevards on today's guided sightseeing tour.

- View the Royal Palace, Spain's largest royal residence
- Pass by the Temple of Debod, a reassembled temple from ancient Egypt
- View the city's many squares, including Plaza Colón and Plaza Neptune
- Explore the Prado, a world-class art museum that began as the private collection of the Spanish monarchy and is home to the works of Goya, Velásquez, and more

### Day 11: Train to Barcelona

### Day 12: Sightseeing tour of Barcelona

*Included meals: breakfast*

Discover why the Catalan capital is touted for its unparalleled architectural landmarks, many of which are UNESCO World Heritage sites.

- Step inside La Sagrada Família, Gaudí's famous masterwork-in-progress
- Drive along Passeig de Gràcia, past Gaudí's "house of bones"
- Stop at Montjuïc, where the 1992 Olympic Games took place, and stroll through Mirador de l'Alcalde Park
- Pass Plaça d'Espanya

## Day 3: Fado Show & Dinner

\$105/\$115\* (3 hours, departs in the evening, dinner included)

Spend your evening at a Lisbon tavern listening to fado. Derived from the Latin word fatum—meaning “prophecy” or “fate”—fado is Portugal’s national musical treasure. Fado’s traditional theme is saudade, a word that doesn’t quite translate to English but conveys a sense of both nostalgia and longing. Dinner is included during this memorable musical evening. Please note: This excursion typically ends around 11pm.

## Day 4: Sintra & the Portuguese Riviera

\$99 (8 hours, departs in the morning)

Journey to the UNESCO World Heritage-listed town of Sintra and learn why the poet Lord Byron once called it a “glorious Eden.” Get a glimpse into royal life during a guided tour of the 19th-century, romanticist Pena Palace. Take a bus and mini-train ride up to this story-book, mountaintop site, which boasts picturesque gardens and sweeping views of the Portuguese countryside. After your tour, you’ll have free time to stroll through Sintra, viewing its colorful villas, small shops, and impeccably manicured gardens. On your way back to Lisbon, take in the coastal scenery of the Portuguese Riviera. You’ll also stop in the old fishing village of Cascais to enjoy free time to discover the town’s winding, narrow streets, and pastel-colored buildings. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 20 days prior to departure.

## Day 6: Traditional Seville Flamenco Show

\$79/\$89\* (3 hours, departs in the evening)

Tonight, get a taste of old Seville during a live flamenco show. Flamenco is a unique and colorful Andalusian art form that combines guitar playing, singing, clapping, and dancing, and this excursion is sure to be one of the highlights of your Spanish journey. Sip an included drink as you watch the authentic performance, which allows expressive lyrics, moving instrumentals, and passionate dancing. After discovering why UNESCO has declared flamenco to be one of the Masterpieces of the Oral and Intangible Heritage of Humanity, enjoy free time to explore the vibrant Santa Cruz neighborhood.

## Day 7: An Evening in Seville: Tapas & Wine

\$105/\$115\* (4 hours, departs in the evening, dinner included)

Head to central Seville and meet up with a local guide. You’ll set off on a food-themed walking tour through the charming Triana neighborhood that will mix history, traditions, and gastronomy together along the way. As you stroll along the river, learn the history of tapas and about Andalusian gastronomy before entering your first tapas bar. From the history of Barrio, the birthplace of flamenco, to the beautiful ceramic tiles, you’ll be sure to gain a new insight on this amazing city while you feast on delicious plates of tapas.

## Day 9: Traditional Spanish Evening

\$119/\$129\* (3 hours, departs in the evening, dinner included)

Start the evening with a stroll through Plaza Mayor. Your Tour Director will tell you about the history of the square, where you’ll see locals and travelers alike. On your way to dinner, walk through the illuminated streets of Madrid, taking in the local neighborhood ambiance in the evening light. Then, enjoy conversation, camaraderie, and live music at one of the oldest restaurants in the city. Between traditional Castilian courses, you’ll be entertained by tuno music, an artistic tradition with its roots in Spain’s universities.

## Day 10: Toledo

\$105/\$115\* (8 hours, departure time varies)

Discover Toledo, the cliff-top city often referred to as La Ciudad Imperial (“The Imperial City”). Upon arrival, you’ll have some free time to explore. Later in the afternoon, your guided tour begins at Toledo Cathedral, a massive, Gothic structure that houses 750 medieval stained glass windows and a treasure trove of golden artifacts. Gaze upon the cathedral’s sacristy, containing masterpieces by the likes of van Dyck, El Greco, Rubens, and Titian. After exploring the labyrinth of medieval alleyways at the heart of the city, you’ll visit the Church of Santo Tomé and one of Europe’s oldest synagogues, Santa María la Blanca. Please note: This tour involves some walking over uneven terrain. Also, depending on the day of the week, the sites visited are subject to change.

## Extension excursion options

### Day 12: Park Güell & La Pedrera

\$109/\$119\* (4 hours, departure time varies)

On today’s excursion, discover the magnificent works of Antoni Gaudí, the famed Spanish architect known for his bold, distinct designs. Casa Milà is the first stop. Take a guided tour of this building, popularly known as “La Pedrera,” which was built by Gaudí between 1905 and 1910. Everything about the building is visually unique, from the wave-like stone structure and grandly designed roof to the apartment that reflects the style of the 20th-century bourgeois. Next, you’ll head to Park Güell, also designed by Gaudí. Your guide will lead you through the park, which contains stunning buildings, intricate stonework, and colorful mosaics. At the top of the park, marvel at the brilliant views of Barcelona.
