Day 1: Travel day

Board your overnight flight to Milan today.

Lake Como Region \rightarrow 2 nights

Day 2: Arrival in Milan & transfer to Lake Como Region

Included meals: welcome dinner Welcome to Italy! Transfer to your hotel in the Lake Como region. Then, meet your Tour Director and fellow travelers at tonight's welcome dinner.

Day 3: Como & Villa Carlotta

Included meals: breakfast

Head out on a morning trip to explore Como, a city known for its mix of cultural and natural attractions.

- Enjoy free time in Como for lunch and shopping, while admiring the lakeside vistas
- Transfer to the beautiful Villa Carlotta to soak in spectacular views from the elaborate villa gardens

Please note: From April through October, a funicular to Brunate will replace the visit to Villa Carlotta.

Day 4: Venice via Verona

Included meals: breakfast, dinner En route to Venice, stop in Verona and walk through the city with your Tour Director.

- Stroll through the city's UNESCO-recognized
 historic center
- Admire the Roman arena, Piazza delle Erbe, and the balcony of Shakespeare's Juliet

Enjoy free time before continuing on to Venice where you'll enjoy an included dinner.

Day 5: Sightseeing tour of Venice

Included meals: breakfast

Admire historic churches, winding canals, and picture-perfect piazzas on a guided tour of the city known as the Queen of the Adriatic.

- Step into the iconic St. Mark's Square and enter St. Mark's Basilica
- View the stately Doge's Palace, built in the Venetian Gothic style in 1340
- Marvel at the Bridge of Sighs, the link between Doge's Palace and the New Prison
- See a glassblowing demonstration to learn about the city's most celebrated art

Day 6: Florence via Ferrara

Included meals: breakfast, dinner On your way to Florence, stop in Ferrara. There, you'll have free time to eat lunch and explore the city's historic center, home to beautiful Renaissance architecture including Este Castle and Palazzo dei Diamanti. Continue on to Florence and sit down for an included dinner.

Day 7: Sightseeing tour of Florence

Included meals: breakfast

Set off on a guided tour of Florence, the city at the center of the Renaissance.

- View the legendary Florence Cathedral, known as the Duomo
- Pass Giotto's Campanile, a masterpiece of Gothic architecture
- See the medieval Ponte Vecchio and Piazza della Signoria, center of Florentine life
- Step inside the Basilica of Santa Croce, burial site of Michelangelo, Machiavelli, and Galileo

Day 9: Transfer to Assisi and sightseeing tour

Included meals: breakfast, dinner Drive through spectacular Umbria to hillside Assisi, where you'll enjoy a guided tour of the town's UNESCO World Heritage sites.

- Visit Assisi's lower and upper basilicas
- See Giotto's magnificent frescoes and other late-medieval art

Sit down for an included dinner this evening.

Day 10: Free day in Assisi

Included meals: breakfast Spend a free day in Assisi or add an excursion. + Perugia: City Highlights & Wine Tasting

Sorrento Peninsula \rightarrow 2 nights

Day 11: Sorrento Peninsula via Pompeii

Included meals: breakfast, dinner En route to the Sorrento peninsula, stop in Pompeii for a guided tour of the city's famed ruins.

- Discover how Roman citizens lived before
 Mount Vesuvius erupted in 79 A.D.
- View the excavated Roman ruins of theaters, villas, temples, and baths

Continue on to the Sorrento peninsula and sit down for an included dinner.

Day 13: Transfer to Rome & sightseeing tour

- Pass by Palatine Hill to see Circus Maximus, the stadium where ancient Romans raced chariots, and the Baths of Caracalla

Day 3: Lake Como Cruise & Bellagio

\$105/\$115* (5 hours, departs in the evening with dinner)

Hop aboard a scenic cruise of Lake Como to soak in some of Italy's most beautiful estates and gardens. Float past charming lakeside towns to Bellagio, a village whose scenery has inspired poets and young lovers for centuries. You'll have time to take in Bellagio's classic beauty before heading to a local restaurant, where you'll sample cuisine from a carefully chosen menu. Please note: Your included meal may be lunch or dinner as departure time varies by season. This excursion is weather-dependent.

Day 5: Gondola Ride: Venice Canal Cruise

\$89/\$99* (25 minutes, departure time varies) More than 100 canals crisscross Venice, and boarding a sleek, black gondola to explore them has become a time-honored tradition. On this memorable excursion, join your fellow travelers for a tour through the canals of Venice, with a gondolier deftly guiding your boat along. Please note: This excursion runs as weather permits, and travelers should feel comfortable getting into and out of the gondolas. A private, two-person gondola ride is available for an additional cost.

Day 5: Private Gondola Ride: Canal Cruise for Two

\$165/\$175* (25 minutes, departure time varies) More than 100 canals crisscross Venice, and boarding a sleek, black gondola to explore them has become a time-honored tradition. On this memorable excursion, you'll enjoy a private gondola cruise for two through the canals of Venice, with a gondolier deftly guiding your boat along.

Please note: This excursion requires two passengers. Cost is per person, and each traveler must book the excursion. Travelers should also feel comfortable getting into and out of the gondolas. This excursion runs as weather permits.

Day 7: Accademia Gallery

\$65 (2 hours, departure time varies)

Home to Michelangelo's masterpiece David, the Accademia Gallery is one of the most famous museums in Florence. Skip the ticket lines, and join a local guide on a tour of the museum as you learn about Renaissance art history and view a variety of pieces, including the marble statue of David. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 70 days prior to departure.

Day 8: Siena & San Gimignano: Tuscan Hilltowns

\$125/\$135* (10 hours, departs in the morning) Discover the essence of Tuscany on a full-day excursion. In Siena, a local guide introduces you to the town and its black-and-white marble duomo, where you'll find brilliantly colored 16th-century frescoes in the Piccolomini Library. You'll have some free time to explore the Campo, the square that serves as the center of civic life in Siena. Then, journey through the countryside to the town of San Gimignano, where you'll have some free time to explore the city's medieval towers or simply admire the Tuscan hills. Later, you'll head to a nearby vineyard, where an included wine tasting awaits. Please note: This excursion involves a moderate amount of walking.

Day 10: Perugia: City Highlights & Wine Tasting

\$115/\$125* (6 hours, departs in the morning, lunch included)

Discover Perugia on a guided tour. While the city is the capital of the Umbria region, it still maintains a charming feel thanks to its rich collection of Renaissance art and sweeping countryside views. You'll see Perugia Cathedral, Palazzo dei Priori, Fontana Maggiore, and the shops of Corso Vannucci. Enter the Collegio del Cambio, home to the historic exchange guild. The building dates back to the 13th century and you'll step inside to view famous, well-preserved frescoes by Renaissance painter Pietro Perugino, Then, head to the Rocca Paolina fortress for a lunch of typical Umbrian cuisine that incorporates seasonally fresh ingredients. Warm, hearty foods like lentil soup will be served in the fall and winter. Whereas summer will bring fresh, bright pasta dishes. You'll also visit a cave wine cellar to enjoy a tasting of three wines-a local white, red, and Vin Santo, or dessert wine.

Day 12: Capri: A Day on the Iconic Island

\$125/\$135* (8 hours, departs in the morning) Travel by ferry to the fabled isle of Capri, a beloved resort since the days of the Roman Republic. Weather permitting, you'll enjoy a boat ride around the island. Later, you'll enjoy free time to discover why everyone from Roman emperors to Sophia Loren has spent their vacations in Capri. If the weather prohibits a boat ride, you'll travel to the village of Anacapri, which offers stunning views of the surrounding scenery. Please note: This excursion is weather-dependent. Travelers prone to seasickness should take the proper precautions.

Day 14: Iconic Sights: Vatican City

\$125 (3.5 hours, departure time varies) This guided tour takes you inside Vatican City—a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the most sacred places in Christendom. This independent citystate within Rome serves as the headquarters of the Roman Catholic Church and is home to the Pope. Upon arrival, turn on your pre-distributed headset and dive into the Vatican's rich history with your local guide. First, visit the Vatican Museums, which are more than 500 years old and house many of the world's most important Classical- and Renaissance-era sculptures. Next, step inside the Sistine Chapel, whose frescoed ceiling is arguably Michelangelo's greatest masterpiece. Finally, pay a visit to the enormous St. Peter's Basilica, the epicenter of the Roman Catholic faith. The artists who have contributed to its glory are some of the best Italy has ever known: Bramante, Peruzzi, Raphael, and

Michelangelo. Masterpieces await at every turn, from Bernini's magnificent bronze canopy to Michelangelo's Pietà.

Please note: Should this excursion fall on a Sunday, it'll be moved to another day of the tour. Backpacks aren't allowed in the Vatican, and shorts and sleeveless shirts are strictly prohibited. Due to closures of certain entrances and pathways, wait times may extend to several hours during busy travel months. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 70 days prior to departure.

Extension excursion options

Day 15: Pasta-Making Class & Dinner

\$119/\$129* (4 hours, departs in the evening, dinner included)

In this hands-on cooking class led by an experienced Italian chef, you'll learn to make pasta—perhaps pillowy ravioli or castellane, a ridged shell pasta that's rolled into a long, oval shape—using traditional techniques you can keep on practicing when you get back home. Then, sit down for dinner and enjoy the dishes you've prepared, along with wine.

Day 15: Walking Tour of Rome's Iconic Sights

\$85/\$95* (3 hours, departs in the morning) Set out for a stroll through central Rome with a local expert. From the Spanish Steps, where Bernini's Baroque-style fountain has stood since the 1600s, head to the intricately carved Trevi Fountain. (Don't forget to toss in a coin and wish for a return trip to Rome!) Enjoy a gelato tasting before entering the Pantheon, the bestpreserved ancient Roman temple. Your walking tour ends at Piazza Navona, the city's most famous square, where you'll view Bernini's stunning the Fountain of the Four Rivers. Please note: Comfortable shoes are recommended, as this excursion involves a moderate amount of walking on cobblestone streets. Entrance is not guaranteed to the Pantheon depending on the day of the week and public holidays.

Day 16: Ancient Rome: St. Paul's Basilica & the Catacombs

\$89/\$99* (4 hours, departure time varies) Descend into Rome's ancient catacombs, where early Christians buried saints and popes alongside commoners. A local guide will lead you through the burial chambers before your visit to St. Paul's Basilica, one of the four most important basilicas of Rome. Originally founded by Constantine the Great, the Basilica also houses the tomb of St. Paul. Please note: Shorts and sleeveless shirts are not permitted within the Basilica. Also, this excursion involves extensive walking and may be challenging for claustrophobic travelers.

*Optional excursions may be purchased up to three days prior to departure or while on tour. Pre-purchased optional excursions cannot be canceled within three days prior to departure or while on tour. Select optional excursions require advance booking and cannot be purchased or canceled after the advanced reservation deadline.
