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Toronto → 3 nights

Day 1: Arrival in Toronto

Included meals: welcome dinner

Welcome to Canada! Get settled in your hotel, then gather with your Tour Director and fellow travelers at tonight's welcome dinner.

Day 2: Sightseeing tour of Toronto

Included meals: breakfast

Join a local expert on a panoramic coach tour of multicultural Toronto, Canada's largest city and the historic, vibrant capital of the province of Ontario.

- Pass the University of Toronto, modernist Toronto City Hall, and the CN Tower, one of the world's tallest buildings
- Drive by Yonge-Dundas Square in the heart of the city's downtown area and pass the St. Lawrence Market, housed in a late 19th-century brick building
- Enter the Royal Ontario Museum, which is dedicated to natural history and cultures around the world

Day 4: Ottawa via Kingston

Included meals: breakfast, dinner

Transfer to Ottawa today, stopping along the way to explore the charming city of Kingston. This "Limestone City" boasts architecturally notable buildings made from local, hand-cut stone.

- Board a cruise boat and sail along the St. Lawrence River through Thousand Islands National Park, which lies along the Canada-U.S. border
- Pass the numerous granite islands of the park and get a peek at the lavish waterfront mansions that dot Millionaires Row

Sit down for an included dinner in Ottawa this evening.

Day 5: Sightseeing tour of Ottawa

Included meals: breakfast

Join your Tour Director and get to know Ottawa, the country's capital. This welcoming urban center is home to a diverse population, world-class museums, and many monuments that pay homage to Canada's national heritage.

- Journey to Parliament Hill to view the soaring, Gothic Revival-style Centre Block, site of the country's Senate, House of Commons, and Library of Parliament
- Learn more about the Canadian Mounties during a visit to the horse stables of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police
- Enter the Canadian War Museum to see the exhibits that pay tribute to the men and women who have served in the armed forces

Quebec City, Quebec → 2 nights

Day 6: Transfer to Quebec City

Included meals: breakfast, dinner

Travel to Quebec City, where you will have a free afternoon to explore on your own. Then, sit down for an included dinner.

Day 7: Sightseeing tour of Quebec City

Included meals: breakfast

Follow a local guide as you immerse yourself in the European charm of this old-world city, which overflows with remnants from its colonial past.

- Stop at the Plains of Abraham, a national battlefield that served as the site of a defining 1759 conflict between France and Britain during the Seven Years' War
- Journey along cobblestone streets on a walking tour of UNESCO-recognized Old Quebec City, which is surrounded by 18th-century fortifications

Enjoy a free afternoon in Quebec City or add an excursion.

Montreal, Quebec → 2 nights

Day 8: Transfer to Montreal & sightseeing tour

Included meals: breakfast

Take in stunning countryside views as you drive to Montreal. This predominantly French-speaking city sits on an island in the St. Lawrence River, and you'll see it all on a panoramic tour with a local guide this afternoon.

- Make a photo stop at Notre-Dame Basilica, an architectural landmark built in the Gothic-Revival style
- Enter Canada's largest basilica, Saint Joseph's Oratory, which is capped by a staggering copper dome

Day 9: Free day in Montreal

Included meals: breakfast, farewell dinner

Enjoy a full free day in Montreal or add an excursion.

Then, join your group at a farewell dinner.

Day 2: CN Tower & Dinner

\$175CAD/\$185CAD* (4 hours, departs in the evening, dinner is included)

The CN Tower is the third tallest tower in the world and the centerpiece of Toronto's skyline. On this evening's excursion, head to the CN Tower in downtown Toronto and take a ride in a glass elevator up to the LookOut level. From 1,136 feet up, you'll have panoramic views of the city. Walk along the glass floors to soak up the scenery from every angle and snap photos through the floor to ceiling glass windows. After, head to a local restaurant to enjoy an included dinner with beer or wine.

Day 3: The Niagara Falls Experience

\$185CAD/\$195CAD* (8 hours, departs in the morning)

Journey to the border of Canada and the United States to experience the thundering beauty of Niagara Falls. Niagara is comprised of three individual cataracts, which plunge at a rate of over 100,000 gallons per second. You'll get an up-close look at this famous landmark as you enjoy a Hornblower boat ride into the mist at the base of the falls. Then eat lunch and discover the surrounding area on your own before driving to Niagara-on-the-Lake. This quaint town is home to local fairs and boutique stores, which you can enjoy during an hour of free time. Then, board the bus and head back to Toronto for a free evening. Please note: This excursion is seasonal and runs May through mid-November only. Layered clothing in the event of cooler weather is recommended for this excursion. Please be prepared for the possibility of seasickness.

Day 7: Scenic Quebec: Sainte-Anne-de-Beaupré & Montmorency Falls

\$89CAD/\$99CAD* (8 hours, departs in the afternoon)

The Côte-de-Beaupré is famous for two landmarks; on this outing, you'll hit both, with an extra stop sandwiched in between. Begin at the rumbling Montmorency Falls, a cascade that stands almost 100 feet taller than Niagara Falls (and makes for a great photo op). Soak in views of the waterfall and its namesake park, then continue up the St. Lawrence River to the Albert Gilles Copper Art Museum. Take off on a guided tour of its exhibits, learning about the fine art of coppersmithing and watching a metalworking demonstration. Finally, head to the Basilica of Sainte-Anne-de-Beaupré and marvel at this holy place. Named after the mother of the Virgin Mary, this sanctuary has drawn pilgrims from around the world since the 1600s—and has reportedly been the site of multiple healing miracles. Please note: This excursion may involve walking up inclines and stairs, so we recommend wearing comfortable shoes.

Day 9: Walking Food Tour of Old Montreal

\$165CAD (4 hours, departs in the afternoon)

Taste some of Montreal's culinary specialties as you follow a local expert on a walking tour through the city's trendiest food districts. Montreal's cuisine is varied, imaginative, multicultural, and delicious, and you'll learn about the culinary scene as you try some of the area's best fare. Please note: This excursion will involve about 2.5 miles of walking, so comfortable sneakers are recommended. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 20 days prior to departure.

Extension excursion options

Day 11: Mont-Tremblant: Scenic Landscapes & Gondola Ride

\$215CAD (6 hours, departs in the morning)

Discover the quaint village of Mont-Tremblant, which is nestled in Quebec's Laurentian Mountains and known for its many ski resorts. Start your day with a scenic gondola ride to the top of the highest mountain peak. Get an overview of the area and admire sweeping views of the stunning countryside, which is dotted with charming, colorful buildings. Then, return to the valley floor to enjoy free time for the rest of the day. Visit a spa or a gallery, go shopping, golfing, or canoeing, or hop in a dune buggy for a ride—the activities offered in this picturesque town are almost endless. Please note: This excursion is seasonal and runs from May through September. There will be some uneven terrain and inclines, so comfortable walking shoes are recommended. We recommend bringing warm clothing in the event of cooler weather. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked by 20 days prior to departure.
