### Day 1: Travel day

Board your overnight flight to Porto today.

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## Porto → 2 nights

### Day 2: Arrival in Porto

*Included meals: welcome dinner*

Welcome to Portugal! Settle in to your hotel in the heart of this 2,000-year-old, UNESCO-listed city. Later, meet your Tour Director and fellow travelers at a welcome dinner.

### Day 3: Sightseeing tour of Porto

*Included meals: breakfast*

Get to know Porto like a true *tripeiro* (Porto resident) as you follow your local guide.

- Wander through the medieval lanes of the Old-World Ribeira district and along the picturesque Douro Riverfront
- View citywide icons, such as the Baroque-style Clérigos Tower, the Gothic facade of the São Francisco Church, and the double-decker Luís I Bridge steel-framed bridge
- Step inside the city's famed neoclassical Stock Exchange Palace

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## Évora → 1 night

### Day 4: Évora via Coimbra

*Included meals: breakfast*

Drive south and stop to explore Coimbra on a guided walking tour of the city's chapel and the country's first university. Later, settle in to your hotel in Évora.

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## Algarve Region → 2 nights

### Day 5: Sightseeing tour of Évora & transfer to the Algarve Region

*Included meals: breakfast, dinner*

Before making your way to the sun-soaked Algarve region, follow a local guide as you stroll through the streets of UNESCO-recognized Évora, one of Europe's oldest continuously inhabited cities.

- Take in the region's whitewashed homes and intricate tilework
- Pass the remains of the Roman temple and enter the Chapel of Bones
- Stop at the Alentejo Cork Factory for a tour to get a closer look at the way corks are made

Continue on to the Algarve region and sit down for an included dinner.

### Day 6: Lagos, Sagres & Cape St. Vincent

*Included meals: breakfast*

Spend a free morning in the Algarve region or add an excursion.

Then, discover the white-sand beaches, dramatic coastline, and small towns of the Algarve region, southern Portugal's beachy hot spot.

- Visit the seafaring towns of Lagos and Sagres
- Enter Sagres Fortress and admire stunning views of the sea
- Make a photo stop at Cape St. Vincent to soak in the scenery from the southwestern-most point in mainland Europe

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## Lisbon → 2 nights

### Day 7: Transfer to Lisbon & sightseeing tour

*Included meals: breakfast*

Travel to Lisbon and get to know the Portuguese capital on a tour with a local guide.

- Admire views of the city from Eduardo VII Park and pass the Praça Marquês de Pombal as you travel along Avenida da Liberdade
- Stop at the waterfront to discover the city's maritime heritage at the Monument to the Discoveries and Tower of Belém
- Enter the church at Jerónimos Monastery, built to honor voyagers
- Walk from Praça do Comércio through the heart of the city to Casa dos Bicos

## Day 3: Douro River Cruise & Port Wine Cellar

\$85/\$95\* (3.5 hours, departs in the afternoon)

Float along the beautiful Douro, the Iberian Peninsula's third-longest river. Take in scenes of Porto's vibrant waterfront and historic Villa Nova de Gaia, home to the region's centuries-old Port wine warehouses. As you cruise, you'll drift under five of the river's most iconic Old-World bridges, passing colorful hillside villas and traditional rabelos (flat-bottomed boats) along the way. Back on shore, pay a visit to one of Porto's most prestigious Port wine cellars. During the guided tour, learn about the long-standing history of Port wine, as well as the ins and outs of Port production and warehousing. Then, sit down to taste three of the cellar's world-famous labels, paired with cheese.

## Day 6: Algarve Coastal Cruise

\$49/\$59\* (2 hours, departure time varies)

The Algarve Coast is incredible from the land—and even more impressive from the water. Board a boat in Lagos and sail along spectacular cliffs and beaches, including the natural rock formations and caves of the famous Ponta da Piedade. You may catch a glimpse of birds and dolphins as you cruise. Please note: This excursion is dependent on both sea conditions and the weather.

## Day 7: Fado Show & Dinner

\$99/\$109\* (3 hours, departs in the evening, dinner included)

Spend your evening at a Lisbon tavern listening to fado. Derived from the Latin word fatum—meaning “prophecy” or “fate”—fado is Portugal's national musical treasure. Fado's traditional theme is saudade, a word that doesn't quite translate to English but conveys a sense of both nostalgia and longing. Dinner is included during this memorable musical evening. Please note: This excursion typically ends around 11pm.

## Day 8: Sintra & the Portuguese Riviera

\$95 (8 hours, departs in the morning)

Journey to the UNESCO World Heritage-listed town of Sintra and learn why the poet Lord Byron once called it a “glorious Eden.” Get a glimpse into royal life during a guided tour of the 19th-century, romanticist Pena Palace. Take a bus and mini-train ride up to this story-book, mountaintop site, which boasts picturesque gardens and sweeping views of the Portuguese countryside. After your tour, you'll have free time to stroll through Sintra, viewing its colorful villas, small shops, and impeccably manicured gardens. On your way back to Lisbon, take in the coastal scenery of the Portuguese Riviera. You'll also stop in the old fishing village of Cascais to enjoy free time to discover the town's winding, narrow streets, and pastel-colored buildings. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 20 days prior to departure.

## Extension excursion options

### Day 9: Religious Heritage of Tomar & Fátima

\$99/\$109\* (9 hours, departs in the morning)

Enjoy a short drive to Tomar where you'll take a guided tour of the city's UNESCO-listed church, the Convent of Christ. This 12th-century site served as a fortress for the Knights Templar and features eight cloisters, which were built between the 15th and 16th centuries. Transfer to Fátima where you'll explore this religiously significant town, most widely known for the story of three young cousins who saw apparitions of an angel in 1916. After that, the village became a pilgrimage site and has drawn Christians for decades. Enter two of the young cousins' homes, known as the houses of Jacinta, and visit the Basilica of Our Lady of Fátima. Later, enjoy free time to grab lunch, shop at stalls selling religious articles, and explore on your own.

### Day 9: Lisbon Home-Hosted Dinner

\$79 (3 hours, departs in the evening, dinner included)

Join a local at their home in Lisbon to enjoy traditional dishes and dine like a true Lisboaeta. During this dinner, you'll receive an authentic understanding of your host's day-to-day life while learning about Portuguese culture and traditions from a new perspective. Please note: Your Tour Director will not attend this excursion. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 20 days prior to departure.

### Day 10: Old World Portugal: Óbidos & Nazaré

\$129/\$139\* (9.5 hours, departs in the morning, lunch included)

Escape the hustle and bustle of Lisbon and spend the day relaxing by the sea in the medieval villages of Óbidos, Nazaré, and Batalha. Picturesque cobblestone streets and color-trimmed buildings make up the romantic village of Óbidos, where you'll pay a visit to Santa Maria Church to admire the colorful ceiling paintings and 17th-century tiles. You'll also have the chance to view the medieval Óbidos castle, known as one of the seven wonders of Portugal. Next, journey to the fishing village of Nazaré for lunch and spectacular coastline views. Spend some time looking out on Nazaré's brightly colored fishing vessels before continuing to Batalha, where you'll enter the UNESCO World Heritage-listed monastery before making your way back to Lisbon.
