New Year's Eve in Lima: Ancient Peru & Machu Picchu

$\textbf{Lima} \rightarrow 3 \text{ nights}$

Day 1: Flight & arrival in Peru

Board your flight to Lima and arrive later this evening.

Day 2: Sightseeing tour of Lima

Included meals: breakfast, welcome lunch Get to know your group at a welcome lunch before entering the Larco Museum to see its collection of pre-Columbian art. Then, follow a local guide on a tour of both the modern and colonial guarters of Lima.

- See Plaza de Armas and the Church of San Francisco, which houses a museum of religious art and 16th-century catacombs
- Enter the Huaca Huallamarca archaeological site

Day 3: Free day in Lima & New Year's Eve celebration

Included meals: breakfast, dinner

Spend a free day discovering Lima at your leisure or add an excursion.

Tonight, ring in New Year's Eve with a celebratory dinner and Champagne toast. The rest of the evening is yours to celebrate on your own or join in the festivities with locals in Lima. + Nazca Lines

$\textbf{Cuzco} \rightarrow 2 \text{ nights}$

Day 4: Flight to Cuzco

Included meals: breakfast, dinner

Travel to the airport this afternoon for your flight to Cuzco. Upon arrival, enjoy free time to acclimate to the elevation as you explore on your own.

Then, get a taste of Peruvian cuisine at a traditional dinner.

Day 5: Sightseeing tour of Cuzco

Included meals: breakfast

Set out on a sightseeing tour of Cuzco, the UNESCO-recognized ancient capital of the Inca Empire.

• Stroll through ruins at Kenko, the "red fortress" of Puca Pucara, and Sacsayhuaman, which was once completely covered in gold

- View the towering Cristo Blanco statue, a thank-you gift from the Palestinian refugees who took shelter in the city during World War II
- Stop at the colonial-era Plaza de Armas to enter Cuzco Cathedral
- Walk through the city center and step inside Convent of Santo Domingo, built by the Spaniards where the Inca temple of Koricancha stood

Enjoy a free evening in Cuzco or add an excursion.

Sacred Valley \rightarrow 1 night

Day 6: The Sacred Valley

Included meals: breakfast, lunch A local guide leads you on a full-day sightseeing tour of the Sacred Valley of the Incas, nestled between Cuzco, Machu Picchu, and the surrounding Andes Mountains.

- Explore traditional markets in the village of
 Pisac
- Stop in Urubamba to enjoy lunch with the group
- Travel to the mysterious Ollantaytambo ruins to explore ancient homes, terraces, and temples within the fortress walls

Machu Picchu \rightarrow 1 night

Day 7: Sightseeing tour of Machu Picchu

Included meals: breakfast, dinner Travel by train to Aguas Calientes, the gateway to Machu Picchu. You'll uncover the Lost City of the Incas, one of the most spectacular archaeological sites in South America and a UNESCO World Heritage site, alongside a local guide.

- Admire incredible views of the misty cloud forest and soaring Huayna Picchu mountain
- Tour the ruins of the ceremonial center, cultivation terraces, and guard house
- Visit Funeral Rock, the Main Temple, the Chamber of Ornaments, and the Sacred Plaza

- Soak in the vistas from the Temple of the Three Windows
- Sit down for an included dinner this evening.

$\textbf{Cuzco} \rightarrow 2 \text{ nights}$

Day 8: Transfer to Cuzco

Included meals: breakfast, lunch Spend a free morning near Machu Picchu or add an excursion to return to the ruins. Rejoin the group for lunch in Aguas Calientes before taking a train back to Cuzco. + Machu Picchu: Return Visit

Day 9: Free day in Cuzco

Included meals: breakfast Enjoy a full free day in Cuzco or add an excursion. + Incan Traditions: Moray, Maras & Chinchero

Overnight Flight \rightarrow 1 night

Day 10: Departure

Village

Included meals: breakfast, farewell lunch Fly to Lima this morning to say goodbye to your group at a farewell lunch. Then, relax in a day room before boarding your flight home tonight or early tomorrow morning. If you are continuing on the tour extension to the Amazon, you'll spend tonight in Lima.

Day 11: Arrival at home

Arrive home today.

In the Amazon, nature is on display like nowhere else (seriously—more things live here than anywhere else in the world). Fly to lquitos, then set out to see incredible wildlife in the world's biggest rainforest and meet indigenous Yagua people to learn about their history.

$Lima \rightarrow 1$ night

Day 10: Flight to Lima

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner Fly to Lima this morning and settle into your hotel. Then, sit down to an included lunch and dinner with your group.

The Amazon \rightarrow 2 nights

Day 11: Flight to Iquitos & rainforest walk

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner Fly to lquitos this morning to begin your adventure in the Amazon. When you arrive, enjoy lunch before setting out on an invigorating walk in the rainforest reserve surrounding your lodge. This evening, sit down to an included dinner with your group.

Please note: Some flights to lquitos depart very early in the morning and breakfast may not be included.

Day 12: Free morning & Yagua village visit

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner Today, enjoy a free morning in the Amazon or add an excursion. Then, sit down for an included lunch before setting out to visit a local village.

- Take a short river cruise to a Yagua indigenous village, keeping your eye out for the elusive pink dolphin
- Learn about the local village culture and watch a blowgun demonstration

This evening, sit down for an included dinner.

$\textbf{Overnight Flight} \rightarrow 1 \text{ night}$

Day 13: Franciscan mission town visit & departure

Included meals: breakfast, lunch

Visit the Franciscan mission town of Indiana this morning. This large river community has grown to include its own market, high school, and small hospital.

Later, fly to Lima and relax in a dayroom before boarding your overnight or early morning flight home.

Day 14: Arrival at home Arrive home today.

Day 3: Nazca Lines

\$499 (12 hours, departs in the morning with lunch) Travel from Lima to the town of Pisco where you'll board a flight to one of the world's greatest remaining mysteries, the Nazca Lines. Visible only from the air, the Lines are massive geoglyphs (geometric designs made of rocks) in the desert, preserved for over 1,000 years in one of the driest places on earth. You'll take an aerial tour of the region, learning about the many theories behind the Lines' origin. Lunch is included. Please note: This optional requires advanced booking and payment at least 45 days prior to departure. The travel time to Pisco is approximately 3.5 hours each way. This excursion may not be appropriate for travelers prone to motion sickness. All travelers will need to report their weight to the pilot before takeoff, and passengers over 223 pounds must notify Go Ahead Tours prior to departure. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 45 days prior to departure.

Day 5: Peruvian Cooking Demonstration & Dinner

\$125/\$135* (3 hours, departs in the evening with dinner)

Watch as an expert chef prepares a traditional Peruvian meal during a cooking demonstration at one of Cuzco's top restaurants on this culinary excursion. With the beautiful Andes Mountains as your backdrop, you'll discover how Peruvians use locally sourced ingredients to create authentic dishes. You'll also learn how to make causa de pollo, a dish made of chicken and potatoes, and tiradito de trucha, a popular seafood-based meal. Afterwards, enjoy a delicious three-course dinner crafted by the expert chef in the restaurant.

Day 8: Machu Picchu: Return Visit

\$115 (duration of visit varies, departure time varies) After experiencing Machu Picchu for the first time with your tour group, take the opportunity to continue exploring the Lost City of the Incas on your own the next morning. You'll marvel at the mysterious Intihuatana stone and discover the cave of the Temple of the Condor, two sites you're only able to see during this morning visit. The Peruvian government only allows select visitors into Machu Picchu each day, but purchasing your return ticket in advance from Go Ahead Tours will guarantee you reentrance to the site on the day of your excursion. Please note: It's possible to purchase return tickets to Machu Picchu directly from the Peruvian government, but tickets are limited in availability and must be purchased well in advance. Additionally, new booking regulations require tickets to be purchased for a specific entry time. Go Ahead Tours reserves tickets for either a 7am or 8am entry time. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 45 days prior to departure.

Day 9: Incan Traditions: Moray, Maras & Chinchero Village

\$89 (7 hours, departs in the morning with lunch)

Spend the morning learning about the roots of the Sacred Valley. Start in Moray, the site of famous Incan ruins that feature large circular terraces used for agricultural experiments. Then continue on to Maras, known for its patchwork of terraced salt-evaporation ponds that have been used since pre-Incan times. Finish your morning in the quaint village of Chinchero to visit a local cooperative of families known as the Balcon del Inka. Here, artisans will demonstrate their traditional weaving and dying techniques and even give you a chance to try your hand at spinning on the loom. Afterward, enjoy an included lunch before heading back to Cuzco. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 20 days prior to departure.

Extension excursion options

Day 12: Amazon Canopy Walk

\$165/\$175* (8 hours, departs in the morning) Go deep into the Amazon for a treetop walk. The day starts with breakfast under the palm-thatched roofs of the ExplorNapo Lodge on the Napo River. Next, hike to the spectacular Canopy Walkway for a bird's-eye view of the rainforest, taking in the lush plants and wildlife along the way. Afterward, visit the ReNuPeRu Ethnobotanical Garden. A local shaman will explain how the 240 plants cultivated here are used for healing.

*Optional excursions may be purchased up to three days prior to departure or while on tour. Pre-purchased optional excursions cannot be canceled within three days prior to departure or while on tour. Select optional excursions require advance booking and cannot be purchased or canceled after the advanced reservation deadline.
