Board your overnight flight to Paris today.

#### Day 2: Arrival in Paris

Included meals: welcome dinner Welcome to France! Meet your Tour Director and fellow travelers at tonight's welcome dinner.

#### Day 3: Sightseeing tour of Paris

Included meals: breakfast

A guided tour introduces you to the architecture, scenery, and history of the City of Light's many neighborhoods, called *arrondissements*.

- Drive down the sycamore-lined Champs-Élysées to view the Arc de Triomphe
- Pass Pont Neuf and the legendary Notre-Dame Cathedral, located on an island in the Seine River
- See the Eiffel Tower, the Palais Garnier opera house, and Place de la Concorde, the city's grandest square
- Marvel at the iconic architecture of the Louvre and Hôtel des Invalides

#### Day 3: Paris Home-Hosted Dinner

\$95 (3 hours, departs in the evening, dinner included) Join a local at their home in Paris to enjoy traditional dishes and dine like a true Parisian. During this dinner, you'll receive an authentic understanding of your host's day-to-day life while learning about French culture and traditions from a new perspective. Please note: Your Tour Director will not attend this excursion. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 20 days prior to departure.

#### Day 4: Food of Paris Walking Tour

\$109 (2.5 hours, departs in the morning) Meet up with a local guide for a culinary-themed walking tour through Le Marais. This chic district is located on the Right Bank of the Seine and is home to some of the city's best boutiques, cocktail bars, and restaurants. You'll walk through Marché des Enfants Rouges, the city's oldest covered market, stopping to sample fresh fruit, cheese, and crepes. Then, watch locals go about their daily lives as you stroll along the charming cafe-lined streets. Your guide will talk about the various flavors and cooking techniques that have come to define French cuisine as you taste fresh pastries and macaroons at local shops. After your tour ends, opt to stay in the area where you can shop and eat lunch or travel back to your hotel. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 20 days prior to departure.

#### Day 5: Dinner in Paris & Seine River Cruise

\$129/\$139\* (5 hours, departs in the evening, dinner included)

Take in the nighttime allure of the City of Light on a special evening excursion. The event begins with dinner at a local restaurant. After you dine, board a boat cruise along the Seine. As you coast along the river and under Paris' bridges, you'll behold the illuminated monuments of the city glittering alongside the riverbanks. Please note: The dress code may vary depending on the restaurant for your dinner. Your Tour Director will advise you on what to wear, but shorts and sneakers are likely to be considered inappropriate attire.

#### Day 6: Château de Vaux-le-Vicomte & Afternoon Tea

\$129 (5 hours, departs in the afternoon) Depart from Paris and transfer to the small village of Maincy to visit the famous Château de Vaux-le-Vicomte. This French Baroque château was created by King Louis XIV's superintendent of finances, Nicolas Fouquet, in the 17th century. The building was architecturally groundbreaking at the time of its conception, and it inspired French architecture, including the Palace of Versailles, for over 100 years after it was built. Explore the grand château and its sprawling gardens on a tour with an expert guide—and learn how the lavish château's creation led to life imprisonment for Fouquet. Then sit down to enjoy tea and snacks on the impressive grounds. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 20 days prior to departure.

#### **Extension excursion options**

#### **Day 7: Paris Theater Show**

\$119/\$129\* (3 hours, departs in the evening) Jump in a taxi and take in the nighttime allure of Paris as you make your way to a famous local theater for an evening of entertainment. The show you'll enjoy is put on by a Parisian company that translates French plays into English subtitles so that English-speaking travelers can experience the culture and day-to-day life in Paris. Learn more about the company's work and the historic theater you're visiting before sitting back to take in the theatrical performance. Please note: The company offers a variety of productions, including French classics, comedies, and musicals, and the specific show is subject to change.
