Day 2: Arrival in Dublin

Included meals: welcome dinner
Welcome to Ireland! Transfer to your hotel and
get settled in. Then, get to know your fellow
travelers and genealogist from

AncestryProGenealogists® at an introductory meeting before sitting down to a welcome dinner with your group.

Day 3: Sightseeing tour of Dublin & National Library of Ireland

Included meals: breakfast

This morning, take a comprehensive tour of Ireland's capital with a local expert leading the way.

- Stop in Phoenix Park, site of the presidential residence, and pass by the Guinness Brewery
- Step inside the soaring St. Patrick's Cathedral, Ireland's largest church
- Pass St Stephen's Green and admire the Georgian architecture of Merrion Square as you go
- See Trinity College and walk past Grafton Street to the Molly Malone statue, ending in the Temple Bar district

Afterward, get an introduction to Irish genealogy and the ways you will be tracing your heritage during a visit to the National Library of Ireland.

- Walk through the building, which houses a variety of Irish records including newspapers, photographs, and maps
- Listen to a presentation led by one of the library's staff members
- Look through the archives to find out more about your Irish ancestry

County Cork \rightarrow 2 nights

Day 4: County Cork via County Kilkenny and County Wexford

Included meals: breakfast, dinner
Travel to Cork, also known as the "Rebel County," stopping in County Kilkenny and County
Wexford along the way.

- Tour the Gothic St. Canice's Cathedral, built in the 13th century
- Visit the Dunbrody Famine Ship & Irish
 Emigrant Experience for a guided tour of the museum

Sit down for an included dinner this evening.

Day 5: Cobh & Cork

Included meals: breakfast

Get a feel for the many sides of Ireland, from rural townlands and charming villages to vibrant cities and iconic castles.

- Discover the town of Cobh, a port once known as Queenstown, from which millions of emigrants left Ireland
- Visit Cobh Heritage Centre for a tour of the museum's exhibits, which tell the story of Irish emigration over the past 150 years
- Step inside the stunning St. Colman's Cathedral
- Explore the city of Cork and enjoy free time to walk through the English Market, a traditional food hall

County Kerry → 2 nights

Day 6: County Kerry via Muckross House

Included meals: breakfast

Travel to County Kerry today. On the way, stop at Muckross House, which was the seat of the Herbert landlord family. Take time to explore this Victorian mansion and stroll through its beautifully manicured gardens, then listen to your genealogist from

Day 7: The Ring of Kerry & Killarney National Park

Included meals: breakfast, dinner
Make your way around the Ring of Kerry, a
112-mile coastal route that covers some of
Ireland's most spectacular scenery.

- Stroll past Lynch's Castle, the Druid Theatre Company, and Eyre Square
- View the city's medieval walls and Spanish Arch
- Peruse authentic Claddagh rings in a local shop

where a simple farmer named Dan O'Hara once lived, to
learn about what rural Irish life was like in the 19th
century. Spend free time exploring on your own before
returning to Galway for the evening.
