# Overnight Flight → 1 night

#### Day 1: Travel day

Board your overnight flight to Palermo today.

# Palermo → 3 nights

#### Day 2: Arrival in Palermo

Included meals: welcome dinner

# Day 3: Sightseeing tour of Palermo & Monreale

Then, embark on a guided tour of the bayside city of Palermo and the hilltop town of Monreale.

- Discover the city's Baroque architecture as you pass the Quattro Canti piazza in the historic center
- Step inside the Cappella Palatina to see the stunning mosaics and artwork
- Head to nearby Monreale and enter Monreale Cathedral, a UNESCO World Heritage site that combines Norman, Arab, and Byzantine architectural styles

# Day 5: Enna Region via Agrigento

Included meals: breakfast, dinner

stopping in Agrigento for a guided walking tour
of the city's fascinating Greek ruins.

Then, continue on to the Enna region and enjoy an included dinner at an *agriturismo*, or farm stay.

# Syracuse → 3 nights

#### Day 6: Syracuse via Piazza Armerina

Included meals: breakfast

On the way to Syracuse, stop for a guided tour of Piazza Armerina and view the stunning mosaics in Villa Romana del Casale, a UNESCO World Heritage site.

#### Day 7: Sightseeing tour of Syracuse

Included meals: breakfast, dinner
Embark on a guided tour of Syracuse, a city
known for its rich Greek history.

- Enter the ancient Greek theater, the most complete of its kind still in existence
- Tour the massive Paradise Quarry and gardens, featuring the cave that artist Caravaggio dubbed "The Ear of Dionysius" for its unique acoustics
- Visit the Roman amphitheater, then cross a bridge to the Island of Ortygia to see the Temple of Apollo and Syracuse Cathedral Sit down for an included dinner featuring local cuisine.

# **Taormina Region** → 2 nights

# Day 9: Transfer to Taormina & sightseeing

Included meals: breakfast, dinner
Transfer to Taormina, where a local guide
introduces you to this scenic town perched high
above the sea.

- Enjoy views of Mount Etna, Taormina
   Cathedral, and Palazzo Corvaja, seat of the first Sicilian parliament
- Visit the town's 2nd-century Greek theater This evening, venture into the foothills surrounding Mount Etna for a traditional Sicilian dinner and wine tasting at a local vineyard.

#### Day 4: Tracing Heritage: The Trapani Region

\$85CAD/\$95CAD\* (8 hours, departs in the morning) Venture to the coastal town of Castellammare del Golfo, known for its deep Sicilian-American ties. Pay a visit to the Ethno-Anthropological Museum, where you'll delve into the agricultural history of the region. End your day in the region's capital of Trapani, where many Sicilian-Americans emigrated from. After enjoying free time to explore the city center, return to Palermo for the evening.

# Day 8: Traditions of Sicily: Villa Lunch & Noto Village

\$175CAD/\$185CAD\* (8 hours, departs in the morning, lunch included)

Start off the day in Noto, a quaint city at the foot of the Hyblaean Mountains. As you stroll along Corso Vittorio Emanuele a local guide will give you the lay of the land, highlighting the UNESCO-recognized cathedral and the city's Baroque-style architecture. Next, travel to a rustic villa, Casa Bianca, owned and run by a Sicilian contessa. With its warm climate, open fields, and fertile soil, Sicily is home to some of Italy's finest foods. Today's authentic family-style meal showcases many of the region's delicious and varied flavors. Please note: On some departures, the excursion may depart in the afternoon and include dinner instead of lunch.

#### Day 10: Mount Etna: Sicily's Volcanic Landscapes

\$129CAD/\$139CAD\* (7 hours, departs in the morning, lunch included)

Travel from Taormina to the base of Mount Etna, Europe's largest and highest active volcano. Here, a local guide will board your bus and you'll ascend up to 5,000 feet, stopping at a scenic vantage point to snap photos and learn about the mountain's long history of eruptions, as well as its native flora and fauna. Continue up to 6,600 feet, where you'll have free time to walk among the volcanic craters and peruse the mountainside shops before sampling local delicacies at an included three-course lunch. Please note:

Comfortable shoes and layered clothing are recommended. Temperatures on the mountain are cool in the summer and can be quite chilly the rest of the year.
