Overnight Flight → 1 night

Day 1: Travel day

Board your overnight flight to Cape Town today.

Cape Town \rightarrow 4 nights

Day 2: Arrival in Cape Town

Welcome to South Africa! Settle in to your hotel this evening.

Day 3: Sightseeing tour of Cape Town

Included meals: breakfast, welcome dinner Embark on a guided tour of Cape Town, a beautiful and culturally rich city.

- Take a cable car ride up Table Mountain and soak in panoramic views of the city below (weather permitting)
- See Signal Hill and the Castle of Good Hope
- Catch glimpses of City Hall and the Houses of Parliament as you drive through the city, stopping in the colorful Bo-Kaap area
- Enter the South African Museum and stroll through the neighboring Company's Gardens

Spend a free afternoon in Cape Town or add an excursion.

Enjoy a welcome dinner with your fellow travelers this evening.

Please note: On some departures, the optional excursion will be offered in the morning and the sightseeing tour will take place in the afternoon. In the event of inclement weather, the visit to Table Mountain will be moved to day 4 or 5. In the unlikely event of poor weather both days, Table Mountain will be replaced with a visit to Signal Hill.

Day 4: Cape Peninsula

Included meals: breakfast, lunch
Spend the day exploring the Cape Peninsula.

- Drive along the Atlantic seaboard, passing the Clifton and Camp's Bay beaches
- Visit the Cape of Good Hope and the lighthouse at Cape Point to soak in beautiful views of where the Atlantic and Indian oceans meet
- Head to Simon's Town for lunch, where you may see some penguins, before arriving back in Cape Town

Johannesburg → 1 night

Day 6: Transfer to Johannesburg & sightseeing tour of Soweto

Included meals: breakfast, dinner
Fly to Johannesburg this morning. Once you arrive, set out on a guided sightseeing tour of the Soweto township.

- See the soccer stadium where the 2010 FIFA World Cup Finals game was played
- Pass Vilakazi Street, once home to both Nelson Mandela and Desmond Tutu—both recipients of the Nobel Peace Prize
- Enter the Hector Pieterson Museum to learn about the 1976 Soweto uprising

Kruger Region → 2 nights

Day 7: Transfer to the Kruger Region

Included meals: breakfast

Drive through scenic landscapes en route to the Kruger region.

Spend a free evening in the Kruger region.

Day 8: Kruger National Park game drives

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner
Set out for a full day of game drives, where you'll
have a chance to see the Big Five game animals:
buffalo, elephants, leopards, lions, and rhinos.
You'll also sit down to enjoy an included lunch at
a private boma in the park.

Then, sit down for an included dinner this evening.

Johannesburg → 1 night

Day 9: Transfer to Johannesburg via Panorama Route

Included meals: breakfast, farewell dinner
See scenic landscapes at every turn as you head
to Johannesburg along the Mpumalanga
Panorama Route.

- Soak in breathtaking views at God's Window (weather permitting)
- See Bourke's Luck Potholes, a collection of natural rock formations
- Stop at the lush, green Blyde River Canyon, where you can see neighboring Mozambique on a clear day

When you arrive in Johannesburg this evening, celebrate your trip with your group at a farewell dinner.

Day 10: Departure

Included meals: breakfast (excluding early morning departures)

Transfer to the airport to board your flight home, or continue on the tour extension to explore Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe.

Day 11: Arrival at home

Arrive home today.

+ Victoria Falls extension

Victoria Falls can often be seen from more than 12 miles away, but you'll get within feet of the world's largest waterfall on this extension. Fly to Zimbabwe where natural wonders and native cultures await.

Victoria Falls → 2 nights

Day 10: Flight to Victoria Falls

Included meals: breakfast, dinner
Fly to Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe, located on the
southern bank of the Zambezi River.

Then, sit down for an included dinner this evening.

Please note: Depending on flight schedules, Chinotimba Township may be offered on day 10 instead of day 11.

Day 11: Sightseeing tour of Victoria Falls, Chinotimba Township & Rose of Charity visits

Included meals: breakfast

Explore Victoria Falls, the largest curtain of falling water in the world, on a guided tour.

- Walk along a network of trails to take in spectacular views of the falls from several vantage points
- Learn about the history, flora, and fauna of the area

Then, take a guided tour of Chinotimba Township, home to the original people of the Victoria Falls area.

- See the oldest traditional houses belonging to the Nambya and Tonga people
- Visit the local market and churches and learn about the culture and lifestyle of township life

After, visit the Rose of Charity organization and learn about their focus on the lives of local children with their initiatives to alleviate poverty and improving education.

Enjoy a free evening in the Victoria Falls region or add an excursion.

Day 3: Robben Island

\$119CAD (4 hours, departs in the afternoon) Today, board a ferry to Robben Island—an enduring reminder of apartheid and South Africa's struggle for freedom. First fortified in the 17th century and used as a jail until 1996, this UNESCO-recognized site imprisoned Nelson Mandela and other political activists and dissidents. There, you'll set off on a tour, guided by a former political prisoner. You'll see the cell where Mandela was held for 18 years, and learn more about the Nobel laureate's life and work. Afterward, take the ferry back to the Victoria & Alfred Waterfront and enjoy free time in the area before ending your outing. Please note: This excursion is weather-dependent. In case of inclement weather, it will take place on the afternoon of day 4. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 20 days prior to departure.

This afternoon, travel from your hotel to the Zambezi River to embark on a leisurely, two-hour cruise. From comfortable chairs on your ship's cool wooden decks, keep watch for the local wildlife, including hippos, crocodiles, and elephants. Your cruise includes light appetizers and drinks, so sit back and relax while meandering down the Zambezi at sunset.

Day 4: Spice Experience & Gold Restaurant Dinner

\$175CAD (3 hours, departs in the evening, includes dinner)

Spend the evening taking part in a unique African dining experience at GOLD Restaurant. Upon arrival, a glass of bubbly, speckled with gold leaf, and an authentic djembe drumming performance greet you. The night continues with an impressive lineup of activities, including a history of spices, a guided spice sensory analysis, and a tasting of 14 different traditional spice-infused dishes. Throughout the night you'll be entertained with stories by staff and live entertainment, all in a private room. It's sure to be a magical evening you won't forget. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 20 days prior to departure.

Day 5: Cape Winelands Tasting & Lunch

\$129CAD/\$139CAD* (6 hours, departs in the morning with lunch)

Leave the city behind for a sensational day in the Cape Winelands—a trio of valleys and the largest winemaking region in South Africa. Depart Cape Town, driving through mountainous, tree-lined terrain, en route to a vineyard in the Stellenbosch Region. Here, you'll get a taste of some of the area's finest vintages—like pinotage, a distinctly South African varietal first created and cultivated in the country. Then, continue to another estate for a second tasting, accompanied by a light lunch. Relax and soak in the scenery, then make your way back to Cape Town.
