Overnight Flight → 1 night

Day 1: Travel day

Board your overnight flight to Palermo today.

Palermo → 3 nights

Day 2: Arrival in Palermo

Included meals: welcome dinner

Welcome to Italy! Meet your Tour Director and fellow travelers at tonight's welcome dinner.

Day 3: Sightseeing tour of Palermo & Monreale

Included meals: breakfast

This morning, embark on a guided tour of the bayside city of Palermo and the hilltop town of Monreale.

- Discover the city's Baroque architecture as you pass the Quattro Canti piazza in the historic center
- Step inside the Cappella Palatina to see the stunning mosaics and artwork
- Head to nearby Monreale and enter Monreale Cathedral, a UNESCO World Heritage site that combines Norman, Arab, and Byzantine architectural styles

Day 4: Free day in Palermo

Included meals: breakfast

Enjoy a free day in Palermo or add an excursion.
+ Ancient Ruins: Segesta & Erice

Enna Region → 1 night

Day 5: Enna Region via Agrigento

Included meals: breakfast, dinner

Travel south through the Sicilian countryside to Agrigento for a guided walking tour of the city's fascinating Greek ruins.
Continue on to the Enna region and sit down for an included dinner.

Syracuse → 4 nights

Day 6: Syracuse via Piazza Armerina

Included meals: breakfast, dinner

On the way to Syracuse, stop for a guided tour of Piazza Armerina and view the stunning mosaics in Villa Romana del Casale, a UNESCO World Heritage site.

Sit down for an included dinner this evening.

Day 7: Sightseeing tour of Syracuse

Included meals: breakfast

Embark on a guided tour of Syracuse, a historic city known for its rich Greek history.

- Visit the Greek theater, the most complete ancient Greek theater still in existence
- Tour the massive Paradise Quarry and gardens, featuring the cave that Caravaggio dubbed "The Ear of Dionysius" for its unique acoustics
- Visit the Roman amphitheater, then cross a bridge to the Island of Ortygia to see the Temple of Apollo and Syracuse Cathedral

Day 8: Free day in Syracuse

Included meals: breakfast

Enjoy a free day in Syracuse or add an excursion.

Day 9: Modica & sightseeing tour of Ragusa

Included meals: breakfast, tasting, wine tasting

Head out into the Sicilian countryside today.

- Make a stop in the city of Modica for a tasting at the oldest chocolate shop in Sicily
 - Head to the hilltop town of Ragusa for a tour with a local guide
 - Stroll through Ragusa Ibla, the UNESCO-protected old town, past Baroque-style palaces and churches
 - Step inside a local shop for a tasting of Cerasuolo di Vittoria wine

Taormina Region → 2 nights

Day 10: Transfer to Taormina & sightseeing tour

Included meals: breakfast

Transfer to Taormina, where a local guide introduces you to this scenic town perched high above the sea.

- Enjoy views of Mount Etna, Taormina Cathedral, and Palazzo Corvaja, seat of the first Sicilian parliament
- Visit the town's 2nd-century Greek theater

Enjoy a free evening in the Taormina region or add an excursion.

Day 4: Ancient Ruins: Segesta & Erice

\$119/\$129* (8 hours, departs in the morning)

Journey to western Sicily to visit the ancient Greek ruins of Segesta. Here, you'll view a magnificent Doric temple and an ancient Greek theater with a local guide. The temple is one of the best preserved and most beautiful Greek archaeological sites in the Mediterranean. Next, visit the well-preserved village of Erice, perched on the summit of Monte San Giuliano. The relics within Erice are fascinating, from its Phoenician walls to its Norman castles. Your guided tour of the town will take you past the town's temple and churches, touching upon the role they played in Erice's history. You'll also try almond wine and pastries during a visit to one of the town's most famous shops.

Day 8: Traditions of Sicily: Villa Lunch & Noto Village

\$125/\$135* (8 hours, departs in the morning, lunch included)

Start off the day in Noto, a quaint city at the foot of the Hyblaean Mountains. As you stroll along Corso Vittorio Emanuele a local guide will give you the lay of the land, highlighting the UNESCO-recognized cathedral and the city's Baroque-style architecture. Next, travel to a rustic villa, Casa Bianca, owned and run by a Sicilian contessa. With its warm climate, open fields, and fertile soil, Sicily is home to some of Italy's finest foods. Today's authentic family-style meal showcases many of the region's delicious and varied flavors. Please note: On some departures, the excursion may depart in the afternoon and include dinner instead of lunch.

Day 10: Traditional Sicilian Dinner & Wine Tasting

\$109/\$119* (4 hours, departs in the evening, dinner included)

Venture into the foothills surrounding Mt. Etna for dinner and a wine tasting at a local vineyard. Like Sicily itself, Sicilian cuisine has been profoundly influenced by the myriad cultures that have made this island their home.

Day 11: Mount Etna: Sicily's Volcanic Landscapes

\$95/\$105* (7 hours, departs in the morning, lunch included)

Travel from Taormina to the base of Mount Etna, Europe's largest and highest active volcano. Here, a local guide will board your bus and you'll ascend up to 5,000 feet, stopping at a scenic vantage point to snap photos and learn about the mountain's long history of eruptions, as well as its native flora and fauna. Continue up to 6,600 feet, where you'll have free time to walk among the volcanic craters and peruse the mountainside shops before sampling local delicacies at an included three-course lunch. Please note: Comfortable shoes and layered clothing are recommended. Temperatures on the mountain are cool in the summer and can be quite chilly the rest of the year.

Extension excursion options

Day 12: Hidden Sicily: Medieval Savoca & Forza d'Agrò

\$65/\$75* (4 hours, departs in the morning)

Delve into the traditional Sicilian villages that served as sets for Francis Ford Coppola's "The Godfather." First, visit Savoca and tour the Church of St. Lucia and the Bar Vitelli. Walk through this medieval village and marvel at its 15th-century buildings and panoramic views of the Mediterranean sea. Continue on to Forza d'Agrò, another "hidden" Sicilian village, where you'll visit the Church of the Annunciation. Please note: The order of villages visited is subject to change. In the event that the Church of the Annunciation is closed, it may only be viewed from the outside. Please note: the visit to Forza d'Agrò is weather dependent, due to safety.

Day 13: Museo Storico dello Sbarco & Historic Catania

\$65/\$75* (6 hours, departs in the morning)

Explore Sicily's World War II history on a visit to the Museo Storico dello Sbarco, an interactive museum featuring striking photographs and a life-size model of a war-era bunker. Then, stroll past the Baroque architecture of Catania's historic center, a UNESCO World Heritage site. You'll see the bustling shops and cafes of Via Etnea and Via dei Crociferi, the grand Teatro Massimo Bellini and the historic Palazzo Biscari. End your tour at the beautiful Piazza del Duomo, home of the famous elephant statue, where you'll have free time for lunch.
