# Day 1: Travel day

Board your overnight flight to Dubai today.

# $\textbf{Dubai} \rightarrow 4 \text{ nights}$

# Day 2: Arrival in Dubai

Welcome to the United Arab Emirates! Take tonight to get settled in to your hotel.

### Day 3: Sightseeing tour of Dubai

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, welcome dinner

Discover both Dubai's traditional and ultramodern sides on today's guided sightseeing tour.

- Walk through the Dubai souk, a traditional marketplace that sells everything from jewelry to textiles
- Hop aboard an *abra*, a traditional water taxi, for a cruise along Dubai Creek
- Get a taste of Emirati cuisine during lunch at the Sheikh Mohammed Centre for Cultural Understanding
- Drive down Sheikh Zayed Road to New Dubai and admire the Burj Khalifa, the tallest tower in the world
- Travel along the coastline, stopping to snap photos at Burj Al Arab, the iconic sail-shaped hotel, and the man-made island of Palm Jumeirah

Tonight, gather with your Tour Director and fellow travelers at a welcome dinner.

### Day 4: Sightseeing tour of Sharjah

Included meals: breakfast

Travel to the neighboring Emirate of Sharjah, the UNESCO-named "cultural capital of the Arab world."

- Visit the Sharjah Heritage Museum in the neighborhood of Old Sharjah
- View the Faisal Mosque, the largest of 600 mosques in the emirate
- Pass by the Souk al Markazi, called the "Blue Souk"
- Make a photo stop at the Al Noor Mosque Later, enjoy a free evening in Dubai or add an excursion.

# Day 6: Abu Dhabi via Abu Dhabi Falcon Hospital

Included meals: breakfast, dinner On your way to Abu Dhabi, stop at the Abu Dhabi Falcon Hospital to learn about rehabilitation efforts and enjoy a demonstration of the ancient hunting technique of falconry. Continue on to Abu Dhabi and sit down for an included dinner.

# Day 7: Sightseeing tour of Abu Dhabi

Included meals: breakfast

Set out to explore Abu Dhabi on a guided tour. • Pass by Saadiyat Island cultural district

- Pass by Galdrya't Island Cultural district
  Pass the Emirates Palace and the Corniche, a
- Pass the Emirates Parace and the Comiche, a five-mile waterfront walkway with incredible views of the Persian Gulf
- Enter the Sheikh Zayed Grand Mosque, one of the largest in the world, and marvel at its detailed marble work and magnificent interiors

# **Al Ain** $\rightarrow$ 1 night

### Day 8: Transfer to Al Ain & sightseeing tour

Included meals: breakfast, tasting, farewell dinner

Travel through the desert to serene Al Ain. When you arrive, get to know the "Garden City" on a guided sightseeing tour.

• Stop at the Al Ain Oasis to enjoy the lush greenery of the surrounding date palm plantations and farms

- Visit a date palmery where you'll learn about the irrigation, production and growth of local foods followed by a date tasting
- Enter the Sheikh Zayed Palace Museum and Al Jahili Fort, which was built to protect the city in 1891

Tonight, celebrate your trip with your fellow travelers at a farewell dinner.

# Day 9: Transfer to Dubai & departure

# Day 9: Transfer to Muscat

Included meals: breakfast, lunch

Cross the border into Oman as you make your way to the capital city of Muscat. En route, sit down for an included lunch and make a photo stop at Nakhal Fort. When you arrive, enjoy an evening guided sightseeing tour.

- Take a panoramic drive through the city, stopping along the Corniche Waterfront for photos
- Stop at the Muttrah Souk and spend free time exploring the traditional market's varied stalls

# Day 10: Nizwa & Desert Forts

Included meals: breakfast

Set out into the desert for a full-day excursion.

- Explore the souks in the center of Nizwa, the oldest city in Oman
- Sample locally grown dates at the souk's famous date market
- Enter Nizwa Fort, which dates back to the 1650s
- Visit Jabrin Castle, once an important academic center for students of astronomy, medicine and Islamic law

# Day 11: Free day in Muscat

Included meals: breakfast Spend a free day in Oman or add an excursion. + Wahiba Sands

# Day 12: Sightseeing tour of Muscat

Included meals: breakfast, dinner Take a closer look at Muscat this morning on a guided sightseeing tour.

- Enter the Sultan Qaboos Grand Mosque, the main mosque in the Sultanate of Oman and marvel at its minarets, intricately decorated interior, and sprawling grounds
- Pass by Fort Al Jalali, Fort Al Mirani and the Al Alam Palace, the ceremonial palace of the Sultan of Oman

This evening, gather with your group for a farewell toast and light dinner.

# Day 13: Departure

Included meals: breakfast (excluding early morning departures) Transfer to the airport for your flight home.

#### Day 4: Burj Khalifa Observation Deck & Dinner

 $219 {\rm CAD}$  (4 hours, departs in the evening, dinner included )

Get an unparalleled look at the city of Dubai from the Burj Khalifa, the tallest tower in the world. Soak in the view from observation decks on the 124th and 125th stories, and learn about the engineering and architectural prowess it took to build the Burj Khalifa. Then, head back to ground level to enjoy a walk along the Dubai Mall fountains, followed by dinner. Please note: In accordance with local laws, alcoholic beverages cannot be served at your meal. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 20 days prior to departure.

#### Day 5: Desert Safari & Bedouin Camp Dinner

\$115CAD/\$125CAD\* (7 hours, departs in

the afternoon with dinner)

Explore the deserts around Dubai, spotting exotic wildlife as you travel over the dunes in a Land Rover 4x4. Then, learn about traditional desert transportation on a camel trek. You'll end your day with group of modern Bedouins. Taste Arabic coffee and dates, then relax and enjoy activities such as henna painting or hookah, a multi-stemmed tobacco pipe. Sit down to a barbecue dinner with the group at a desert retreat and take in a belly dancing performance after your meal. Please note: The terrain while driving over the sand dunes is bumpy and rough. Take the proper precautions if you experience motion sickness.

### Day 7: Louvre Abu Dhabi

\$109CAD (2 hours, departs in the afternoon) Make your way to Saadiyat Island where you'll pay a visit to the largest museum on the Arabian Peninsula: the Louvre Abu Dhabi. Here, join a local art expert for a guided tour of the museum, which is a partner to the Louvre Museum in Paris and contains art from all over the world. After your guided tour, enjoy free time to continue exploring the museum at your leisure. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 20 days prior to departure.

### **Extension excursion options**

#### Day 11: Wahiba Sands

\$199CAD (10 hours, departs in the morning with lunch)

Discover the incredible landscapes and ancient cultures of Oman. Set out over the Western Hajar Mountains in a Jeep 4x4, admiring rock formations that are colored green and red by iron ore. Stop in the town of Al Mudhaireb to see the ruins of ancient watchtowers and villages, then visit Wadi Bani Khalid to enjoy a picnic lunch in the oasis-like valley. Continue on to a dune drive in the stark and stunning Wahiba Sands, where you'll meet a group of Bedouins living as their ancestors have for centuries. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 20 days prior to departure.
