Day 1: Travel day

Board your overnight flight to Milan today.

Day 2: Arrival in Milan

Included meals: welcome dinner
Welcome to Italy! Meet your Tour Director and fellow travelers at tonight's welcome dinner.

Day 3: Sightseeing tour of Milan

Included meals: breakfast

Meet up with a local guide and embark on a sightseeing tour of Italy's fashion capital.

- Pass by the 15th-century Sforza Castle.
- Walk through the Brera District and see the statue of Leonardo da Vinci, the Galleria Vittorio Emanuele, and Piazza della Scala.
- Enter Teatro alla Scala and view the elegant concert hall.
- Visit the theater's museum to see exhibits that highlight Italy's historic connection to the opera.
- Step inside the Gothic-style Milan Cathedral, Italy's largest cathedral.

Enjoy a free afternoon to explore Milan at your leisure.

Lake Como Region → 2 nights

Day 4: Transfer to Lake Como Region

Included meals: breakfast, dinner
Travel to the Lake Como region this morning.
Upon arrival, head out to explore Como, known for its mix of cultural and natural attractions.
Enjoy free time in Como for lunch and shopping, while admiring the lakeside vistas and sit down for an included dinner this evening.

Day 5: Villa Carlotta, Lake Como cruise & Bellagio

Included meals: breakfast

Head out on a morning trip to explore the Lake Como area where you'll have a chance to admire the beautiful architecture, breathtaking views, and cruise the crystal-clear turquoise waters.

- Transfer to the beautiful Villa Carlotta to soak in spectacular views from the elaborate villa gardens.
- Embark on a scenic cruise on Lake Como and soak in some of Italy's most beautiful estates and gardens.
- Float past charming lakeside towns to Bellagio, a village whose scenery has inspired poets and young lovers for centuries.
- Enjoy free time in Bellagio to grab dinner, shop, and explore at your own pace.

Please note: From November through February, a funicular to Brunate will replace the visit to Villa Carlotta.

Return to your hotel in the Lake Como region by bus and enjoy a free evening.

Italian Riviera → 3 nights

Day 6: Italian Riviera via Certosa di Pavia monastery

Included meals: breakfast, dinner
Leaving the Lake Como region, stop in
Lombardy to visit the exceptionally beautiful
Certosa di Pavia monastery, a UNESCO World
Heritage site. Then, continue south to the
seaside paradise of the Italian Riviera and sit
down for an included dinner.

Day 7: Sightseeing tour of Cinque Terre

Included meals: breakfast

Join your Tour Director to discover Cinque Terre, an idyllic cluster of five villages set on seaside cliffs.

- Board a train to Monterosso and soak in views of the pebble beach that the village is known for.
- Hop about a boat to the village of Vernazza and admire the colorful houses that dot the waterfront.
- Continue by boat to the dramatic coastal village of Riomaggiore.
- Learn about Via dell'Amore, one of the area's most famous hiking paths, which connects two of the five villages.
- Enjoy short walks through each village before spending free time exploring, shopping, and eating.

 Admire the Liguria regions' varied landscape as you transfer back to your hotel by train.

Please note: The boat ride is weather-dependent. In the case of inclement weather, you'll visit the villages by train. In addition, the specific villages you visit may vary.

Day 9: Venice via Verona

Included meals: breakfast
En route to Venice, stop in Verona and walk
through the city with a local guide.

- Stroll through the city's UNESCO-recognized historic center.
- Admire the Roman arena, Piazza delle Erbe, and the balcony of Shakespeare's Juliet.

Enjoy free time before continuing on to Venice.

Day 10: Sightseeing tour of Venice

Included meals: breakfast, farewell dinner
Admire historic churches, winding canals, and
picture-perfect piazzas on a guided tour of the
city known as the Queen of the Adriatic.

- Step into the iconic St. Mark's Square and enter St. Mark's Basilica.
- View the stately Doge's Palace, built in the Venetian Gothic style in 1340.
- Marvel at the Bridge of Sighs, the link between Doge's Palace and the New Prison.
- See a glassblowing demonstration to learn about the city's most celebrated art.

Enjoy a free afternoon in Venice or add an excursion.

Later, celebrate your trip at a farewell dinner with your fellow travelers.

- View the legendary Florence Cathedral, known as the Duomo.
- Pass Giotto's Campanile, a masterpiece of Gothic architecture.
- Walk past Piazza della Repubblica to the medieval Ponte Vecchio.
- Stroll along the Arno River and through the courtyard of the Uffizi Gallery to Piazza della Signoria, center of Florentine life.

Day 8: Villages of the Italian Riviera & Lunch

\$115/\$125* (7.5 hours, departs in the morning, lunch included)

Drive through the countryside to Sestri Levante, a beautiful seaside village located on the Italian Riviera. Here, you'll have free time to explore on your own before setting out on a walk along the coastline to Baia delle Silenzio, one of the city's sparkling azure bays. Enjoy stunning bayside views while eating a delicious lunch of local seafood and meat specialties paired with regional wine. Then, stroll through the village castle gardens and take in views of both Baia delle Silenzio and another bay known as Baia delle Favole. Next, hop aboard a ferry to make your way to the breathtaking village of Portofino. Artists and celebrities alike flock to this celebrated destination, and you'll enjoy free time for shopping or relaxing while admiring the picturesque vistas of the harbor. Please note: This excursion is seasonal and runs from March through November, It also involves a moderate amount of walking.

Day 10: Gondola Ride: Venice Canal Cruise

\$89/\$99* (25 minutes, departure time varies)
More than 100 canals crisscross Venice, and boarding a sleek, black gondola to explore them has become a time-honored tradition. On this memorable excursion, join your fellow travelers for a tour through the canals of Venice, with a gondolier deftly guiding your boat along. Please note: This excursion runs as weather permits, and travelers should feel comfortable getting into and out of the gondolas. A private, two-person gondola ride is available for an additional cost.

Day 10: Private Gondola Ride: Canal Cruise for Two

\$165/\$175* (25 minutes, departure time varies) More than 100 canals crisscross Venice, and boarding a sleek, black gondola to explore them has become a time-honored tradition. On this memorable excursion, you'll enjoy a private gondola cruise for two through the canals of Venice, with a gondolier deftly guiding your boat along.

Please note: This excursion requires two passengers. Cost is per person, and each traveler must book the excursion. Travelers should also feel comfortable getting into and out of the gondolas. This excursion runs as weather permits.

Day 12: Accademia Gallery

\$65 (2 hours, departure time varies)

Home to Michelangelo's masterpiece David, the

Accademia Gallery is one of the most famous museums
in Florence. Skip the ticket lines, and join a local guide
on a tour of the museum as you learn about

Renaissance art history and view a variety of pieces,
including the marble statue of David. This excursion
requires advance reservation and must be booked at
least 70 days prior to departure.

Day 13: Siena & San Gimignano: Tuscan Hilltowns

\$125/\$135* (10 hours, departs in the morning)
Discover the essence of Tuscany on a full-day
excursion. In Siena, a local guide introduces you to the
town and its black-and-white marble duomo, where
you'll find brilliantly colored 16th-century frescoes in the
Piccolomini Library. You'll have some free time to
explore the Campo, the square that serves as the center
of civic life in Siena. Then, journey through the
countryside to the town of San Gimignano, where you'll
have some free time to explore the city's medieval
towers or simply admire the Tuscan hills. Later, you'll
head to a nearby vineyard, where an included wine
tasting awaits. Please note: This excursion involves a
moderate amount of walking.
